LEARNER INFORMATION SYSTEM (LIS) END OF SCHOOL YEAR (EOSY) 2023-2024 UPDATING

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors **Public Schools District Supervisors** All Public and Private School Principals All Others Concerned

- 1. Pursuant to the Unnumbered Memorandum from the Office of the Undersecretary for Administration titled "Learner Information System (LIS) End of School Year (EOSY) 2023-2024 Updating", this Office informs all public and private schools that EOSY updating facility will be opened until July 28, 2024.
- 2. For private schools, the EOSY updating facility was opened last **April 8, 2024**. On the other hand, Public elementary and secondary schools may start once the promotional status and other necessary data for the EOSY updating become available within the said timelines and should not compromise the one-month non-negotiable vacation of teachers.
- 3. In relation to EOSY finalization, schools with pending enrollment in the LIS shall document/s email the supporting of learners depedbataan.planning.research@deped.gov.ph on or before May 8, 2024. The following table presents the documentary requirements for pending LIS Request:

Enrollment Issue	Documents to be submitted
Enrollment w/ Gap or Enrollment of ineligible	Copy of SF10 (Permanent Record)
Temporary Enrollment	Copy of Affidavit of Undertaking (as per DepEd Order No. 3, s. 2018)
Correction of Learner Profile or LRN Approval	Copy of Birth Certificate and/or other relevant documents
Correction of Grade level	Copy of SF10 and/or PEPT Certificate
Request from non-graded to graded and vice-versa	Medical assessment

The End of School Year (EOSY) updating in the Learner Information System (LIS) is one of the crucial data collection activities and responsibilities that annually done and comply with by all schools offering basic education nationwide as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 27, s. 2019 titled: Guidelines on the Yearly Collection of Data/Information Requirements and Validation Processes. The data collected and generated in this updating are vital in tracking the academic performance and promotional status of learners, as well as in computing relevant performance indicators.

In this regard, all private schools and State/Local Universities and Colleges (SUCs/LUCs) offering basic education shall be guided accordingly that the EOSY Updating facility will be opened from 08 April 2024 to 28 July 2024. While public elementary and secondary schools may start once the promotional status and other necessary data for the EOSY updating are already available within the said timelines and not compromising the one month non-negotiable vacation of teachers.
