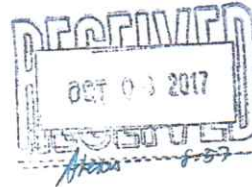

SUBJECT : Values Restoration Program

The Council for the Restoration of Filipino Values (CRFV), a Civil Service Commission Accredited Learning and Development Institution, aims to introduce its **Values Restoration Program** as a soft approach of the government's anti-corruption initiatives.

In line with this, government agencies are encouraged to support the program by appointing at least two Values Restoration Officers (VRO), from supervisory level and rank and file from their central, regional, provincial, and field offices or units. The designated VRO shall lead the discussion of a common value every week after the flag ceremony using the CRFV-authored book **transforming the Nation through Values** and the CD with Powerpoint presentations containing the same. Moreover, the designated VRO shall coordinate all VRP matters in their agencies and attend the Trainer's Trainings and other seminars and meetings to be conducted by the CRFV.

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VRO Training the Trainers (VROTTT) Training Design

I. Course Description:

This course is designed to cultivate ethical and transformational leaders with strong values who will commit themselves to the pursuit of transformation as Values Restoration Officers, values champions, or values advocates. The course integrates transformational leadership, skills development, and values enhancement, to equip the participants with the knowledge, skills, and attitudes needed to transform their respective agencies/offices into values-based organizations. This course aligns with the Values Restoration Program (VRP), which takes a soft approach to anti-corruption initiatives.

II. Performance and Learning Objectives:

Performance Objectives

By the end of the 3-day training, participants will be able to apply the concepts and skills in Values Advocacy and formulate a plan to champion values-based organization in public service.

Learning Objectives

By the end of the training, the participants shall be able to:

1. Explain the goals and importance of Values Restoration Program or values-anchored programs in developing values-based organization that contributes in nation-building;
2. Identify relevant strategies to embody the values of a Values Restoration Officer, values champion, or values advocate in order to effectively lead and advocate for transformation through values in public service;
3. Create a brief Values Advocacy Presentation; and
4. Develop an Action Plan for values development/enhancement in their respective offices/agencies.

1. Transforming the Nation through Values: An Introduction
2. Developing a Values Advocacy Presentation & Principles of Trainer Excellence
 - a. Tools and Techniques to increase effectiveness of values presentations
 - b. Different roles of a values champion/trainer and trainee/audience, and how to manage the latter.
 - c. The professional presence in values advocacy presentation
3. Core Values of a Values Restoration Officer:
 - Value-focus: Spirituality
 - Value-focus: Excellence
 - Value-focus: Integrity
 - Value-focus: Taming the Tongue
 - Value-focus: Patriotism (Selfless Love for the Nation)

2. Interactive Discussion
3. Actual values advocacy presentation
4. Give and receive feedback
5. Other participative digital methodologies



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V. Target Participants:

This learning event is designed for leaders and aspiring leaders who are endorsed, designated or appointed as Values Restoration Officers, values advocates, values champions, or values development focal person by their respective offices or agencies.

Guide in selecting Values Restoration Officer (VRO)/values champion/values advocate:

- *He/she must be of good moral character and active advocate of good governance by modeling it before the government personnel.*
- *He/she is of good conduct based on the evaluation of his/her Head of Office and based on the judgment and general observation of his/her colleagues in the office/agency.*
- *He/she is one of the best performing employees in the agency/office and has not been held guilty or liable of nonfeasance, misfeasance, or malfeasance in office or of any flagrant violation of laws and reasonable rules and regulations of the office/agency.*
