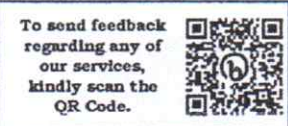

WHEREAS, the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child states that children have the right to show their thoughts freely;

WHEREAS, Section 17, Article VII of the Intern Constitution and By-Laws of the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSSLG) states that the Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSSLG) must serve as the representative of the student body in raising their concerns, opinions, and grievances to the concerned individual or unit;

WHEREAS, Section 18, Article VI of the same document supports the responsibility aforementioned in Article VII, where it states that every learner must enjoy the right to have proper representation and the right to be heard concerning his or her welfare and education

WHEREAS, Section 19, Article IV of the Intern Constitution and By-Laws of the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSSLG) states that the SSSLG shall provide a channel for learners' opinions, suggestions, grievances, and other concerns affecting their rights and welfare in school;




