

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### KEC19 Conference Brief

The Philippine Community eCenter (CeC) Network or PhilCeCNet, a non-stock and non-profit organization, is a learning and collaborative community of CeC stakeholders which supports the building of responsive, efficient, valuable and sustainable CeCs. It was born from the desire of various CeC stakeholders to harmonize CeC initiatives, share knowledge and experiences, and achieve a commonality of direction and operations for maximum impact. These stakeholders include National Government Agencies, Local Government Units, Academe, Private Sector, Non-Government Organizations (NGO), Media, Funding Institutions, CeC Managers, and CeC Users.

The Knowledge Exchange Conference (KEC) on eCenters is an annual gathering of ICT4D and Public Internet Access advocates which include Local Chief Executives, Knowledge Managers/Workers and eCenter stakeholders in the country such as FITS Centers, Tech4ED Centers, Digital Transformation Centers and more. It is considered to be a venue where networking is espoused, best practices on eCenter operations, services and applications are shared, ICT trends and updates are unveiled, and accomplishments are showcased. eCenters were established primarily to provide Internet access to the public or to connect and link the community to cyberspace. This creates a hub for digital literacy training, online access to government services, employment, and entrepreneurship opportunities.

The theme of the 19th Knowledge Exchange Conference (KEC19) organized by the Philippine Community eCenter Network (PhilCeCNet) and co-organized by the Department of Information Communication and Technology (DICT) and Partners - Empowering Futures: Building Capacities and Connecting Communities - is the second milestone of PhilCeCNet's Digital Inclusion and Transformation for All Roadmap.

This year's KEC focuses on:

1. Conducting a Competency and Output Based Certification Training in accordance with the National Competency Standards for Knowledge Workers;
2. Providing the latest updates on Information and Communications Technology (ICT) in promoting Government Services and Citizen Empowerment; and
3. Sharing best practices among Community eCenter operators.
