



PROJECT KADATE "KABATAAN AYAW SA DROGA AT TERORISMO" SUMMIT

- 1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 9165 titled "Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2022" and DepEd Order No. 12, s. 2009, this Office through the Education Support Services Division (ESSD) will conduct the PROJECT KADATE "Kabataan Ayaw sa Droga at Terorismo" Summit with the theme "Kabataan Katuwang sa Pagsulong ng Drug-Free Schools" on June 27-28, 2024 in Eurotel, Don Cuatro De Julio, Angeles, Pampanga to be hosted by Schools Division Office of City of San Fernando.
- 2. Project KADATE "Kabataan Ayaw sa Droga at Terorismo" was initiated and conceptualized by DepEd RO III as preventive education and information dissemination program to counter the dangers and ill-effects of illegal drugs and any act of terrorism. This project is anchored with "DepEd Region III: Promoting Drug-Free and Terrorism-Free Schools. Thus, this project will help students to embrace an illegal drug-free lifestyle and stay away from terrorism that might destroy their lives and future. Through this project, students will be empowered to be the catalysts within his peer groups in promoting the ill-effects of using illegal drugs and joining in any act of terrorism and its legal consequences.
