

SUBJECT : **REITERATION OF THE SUBMISSION OF RAPID ASSESSMENT OF DAMAGES REPORT (RADaR) OF SCHOOLS AFFECTED BY SOUTHWEST MONSOON AND SUPER TYPHOON CARINA**

DATE : 29 July 2024

Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 21, s. 2015 titled "Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Coordination and Information Management Protocol" and as a legal requirement under the DepEd Order No. 33, s. 2021, titled "School-Based Disaster Preparedness and Response Measures for Tropical Cyclones, Flooding, and other Weather-Related Disturbances and Calamities", the submission of the Rapid Assessment of Damages Report (RADaR) by the School DRRM Coordinators shall be done within **72 hours after the occurrence** of any hazard or emergency.

With this, all concerned divisions shall reiterate the submission of RADaR ICOW Southwest Monsoon and Super Typhoon "Carina" to their respective school DRRM Coordinators. While the DRRMS recognized the challenges in reporting the damages in the said application, the schools shall submit an offline RADaR in editable MS Excel file format to their respective Schools Division Offices (SDOs).

Further, all Division DRRM Teams through the leadership of the Division DRRM Coordinator shall conduct validation of the submitted RADaR of all schools. The Division DRRM Coordinator shall transmit the vetted RADaR to the Regional Office to facilitate the downloading of response intervention funds to qualified schools.

To reiterate, all vetted RADaR shall be forwarded to the Regional Office and furnished to the DRRMS a copy of the report for monitoring purposes. All vetted RADaR shall be submitted no later than **07 August 2024** through drmsa@deped.gov.ph.
