ENGLISH COMPETENCY WEEK News Writing Competition

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- Participants are required to wear their respective school uniforms and display their school IDs, during the contest.
- Requests for assistance and/or points of clarification should be directed to assigned proctors who will in turn, refer the matter to the contest organizers.
- Contestants are not allowed to place any identifying marks on their entries. For
 identification purposes, only their assigned numbers should be written on the upper lefthand corner of their paper.
- A place is designated for school advisors, coaches, and parents to stay during the contest proper. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.
- 5. Certificates of participation will be given to contestants upon submission of their entries; after which they will be allowed to leave the contest venue.
- 6. Winners will be announced on Gov. Joet Garcia's Official Facebook Page.
- Awards will be given on September 16, 2024. In case of any changes in the date, the PIO
 will send a notice regarding the new schedule for the awards.
- 8. The decision of the board of judges is final.

MECHANICS:

Eligibility: Each district in Bataan and Division of Balanga City may send one (1) representative for each category.

Categories: Elementary, Junior High School, and Senior High School

Registration: Participants must be officially endorsed by SDO Bataan and SDO City of Balanga. Participants may come from either public or private schools.

Criteria for Judging: Entries will be judged based on the following:

Technical (40%)

- 1. Writing is active, precise, and stylistically exact.
- 2. Paragraph transitions are smooth and logical.
- 3. Direct and indirect quotes are used effectively.
- 4. Correct usage of grammar, spelling, and overall neatness.

Content (50%)

- 1. The lead consists of the most timely and newsworthy information.
- 2. Facts are presented in descending order of importance.
- All relevant news questions are answered.

Ethics (10%)

1. Editorialization is avoided.

Awards: Certificates of Recognition and prizes will be awarded to the top three entries in each category, and certificates of participation will be given to all participants.

Prizes:

Champion - Php5,000

1st Runner-up - Php3,000

2nd Runner-up - Php2,000

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- 1. Plagiarism will result in disqualification.
- 2. Entries must adhere to ethical journalism standards.
- 3. Judges' decision is final.
- 4. Students have 1 hour to complete the contest; a time signal is given when 15 minutes remain. Submissions after one hour will not be considered.
- 5. Students are given a prompt and they are to respond with a news story. They are required to handwrite their news stories legibly.
- 6. All papers are read and critiqued, with the top three papers ranked. There are no ties.
