COMPETITION PRIMER

The STARS Award (STEM Teachers Achieving Remarkable Success in Society) recognizes STEM teachers/educators who drive innovation, sustainability, and social responsibility through impactful STEM projects that inspire and transform communities beyond the classroom. The award celebrates and amplifies the efforts of STEM teachers dedicated to education and community service, setting a high standard for excellence in community-oriented STEM education. In doing so, it is hoped that these communities will be encouraged to continue with their STEM advocacies and help in achieving the goal of the DOST-Science Education Institute of a STEM-strong country.

ELIGIBILITY

- This competition is open to a team of Filipino teachers currently teaching in public or private schools.
- The proposing team shall be composed of three (3) STEM teachers at any level in basic education
- At least one team member should have experience organizing exemplary communitylevel STEM-related activities and should be able to provide evidence and documentation.

Initial Screening and Evaluation October 26 – November 14, 2024	 All submitted proposals shall be screened and evaluated by the Search Committee The following criteria will be used for the selection:
	 Impact (30%) Measurable outcomes of the proposed project in terms of community benefits. Long-term sustainability and positive change to be brought about by the proposed project.
	 Innovation (25%) Creativity in responding to and addressing community needs through STEM Use of innovative methods, technologies, or approaches.
	Scalability (15%) Potential for the proposed project to be replicated or adapted in other communities. Feasibility of implementation in different settings or regions.
	Community Engagement (15%) Level of involvement and collaboration with community members. Contribution to raising awareness and education on STEM-related issues.
	 5. Presentation and Documentation (15%) Clarity, coherence, and professionalism of the proposal Quality of supporting materials (e.g., photos, videos, endorsements).
Announcement of Semi- finalists November 15, 2024	After the screening and evaluation, semi-finalists shall be announced.
STARS CAMP (Capacitating and Mentoring Program) November 25-27, 2024	 All the semi-finalists are required to attend the STARS CAMP. The proposal must be presented by each team. Proposals are subject to the revisions as recommended by the Search committee and mentors. After the CAMP, three (3) proposals will be chosen as finalists for implementation.
Implementation and Monitoring Activities February to October 2025	 The Search committee shall conduct monitoring and evaluation activities. Implementation activities should be accomplished within the deadline.

- The teams may win the following awards:

Stellar Community Award

For the project that demonstrates outstanding performance and remarkable results, shining brightly in the community.

Nebula Award

For the project that shows incredible potential and creativity, like a nebula giving birth to new stars.

Celestial Excellence Award

For the project that achieves the highest level of excellence and impact, representing the pinnacle of success
