

and other Eco Activities such as Composting, Waste Management Education, and Biodiversity Awareness.



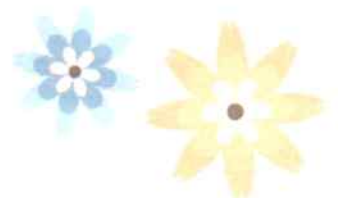
MISSION
