

- Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 40 s. 2012 entitled "DepEd Child Protection Policy" which embodies DepEd strong commitment to respect, protect, fulfill and promote the rights of children in the basic education.
- The Learner Rights and Protection Office (LRPO) is mandated as the lead office of the Department in formulating policies, planning, implementing, coordinating and monitoring projects, programs and activities concerning all matters pertaining to the rights of the learners in basic education.
- Further, Learners Rights and Protection Office (LRPO) in collaboration with Bureau of Learning and Development-Teaching Division developed Learning Action Cell (LAC) Session Guides on Positive Discipline which aims to strengthen the use of positive discipline as a behavioral management technique in schools.
- Relative to this, the Department of Education (DepEd) Regional Office III through the Education Support Services Division (ESSD) shall conduct the Training-Workshop on The Positive Discipline Learning Action Cell (LAC) Session Guides on October 14-16, 2024 in Clark, Pampanga.
