## REGIONAL INTER-AGENCY COMMITTEE ON FILIPINO FAMILY (RIAC FF) REGIONAL SEARCH FOR NATATANGING PAMILYANG PILIPINO **GUIDELINES**

#### SCREENING PROCEDURES

- The DSWD, through the RIAC FF, shall launch the Search and disseminate information on the guidelines and the Call for Nomination through letters, social media, and other possible means.
- Each nomination shall be supported by the prescribed nomination form duly accomplished and signed together with the complete supporting documents (means of verification) scanned copies of which will be uploaded to a google drive.

## REGIONAL SEARCH FOR NATATANGING PAMILYANG PILIPINO (NPP)

- 1. The Regional Awards Committee established in the RIAC FF shall further disseminate the information on the Regional Search for Natatanging Pamilyang Pilipino in cooperation with other partners.
- 2. LGUs, DSWD accredited NGOs, Organizations, and entities engaged in families may endorse a nominee (one nominee per organization) together with the following complete documents:
  - Accomplished Nomination Form that contains:
    - Profile of the family, activities, awards received, community participation, records of accomplishments, and recognitions;
    - ✓ A Write-Up of minimum 500 and maximum of 1,000 words about the family including narratives about the family highlighting contributing factors to the matatag, maginhawa and panatag indicators; and
    - Conform to be signed by authorized / designated representatives of the Family nominated to the NPP.
  - Three (3) recommendations from the Barangay / credible source (local officials, parish church, any authorized / credible organizations)
  - Photos of the family and their activities (family reunions, school, and other extracurricular activities)
  - Video with link of the nominated families
- 3. The Regional Awards Committee will thoroughly facilitate the first phase of the selection process based on the received nominations within the indicated timelines and taking into consideration the criteria of assessment and completeness of submitted documents.
  - All nominations must be submitted by the nominator using the prescribed Nomination Forms with complete supporting documents via on or before the set deadline.
  - Screening and review of the nomination forms, documents, and other credentials of the nominees shall be done by the Regional Awards Committee based on established internal policies and with the following allocations:

Total	100%
Interview	20%
Validation of Entries	40%
Documentation Review	40%

To qualify for the next level of the evaluation process, the nominees shall maintain a minimum score of eighty percent (80%) of indicated weight allocation.

- Document Review. Shall entail checking completeness of documents required for the nomination including the assessment of information based on the compliance to the eligibility criteria and assessment tool.
- Validation of Entries. Shall entail posting of the semi-finalists and the presentation of the family's key accomplishments and information based on the eligibility criteria and assessment tool with the following specific procedures:
  - ✓ Semi-Finalists / Shortlisted nominees will be notified for their qualification;
  - To help in the validation the committee may opt to conduct interviews, and request semi-finalist to deliver a minimum of 5 minutes and maximum of 10 minutes presentation highlighting key information about their family based on the three main categories: Matatag, Maginhawa and Panatag. The Regional Committee may raise queries and clarifications based on the presentation;
  - The Regional Committee will conduct background information interviews as necessary; and
  - The members of the regional committee will convene and discuss their individual scores, and come up with a consensus as to the ratings of the nominated families.
- Interview. The validation may be conducted through an interview of the finalists via online or conduct of site visits. The activity aims for the awards committee to get to know the nominees / regional awardees.
  - The Regional Committee may opt to conduct final interviews to further validate the result of their rates and ranking.
- 4. The Regional Awards Committee shall deliberate and choose only one (1) nominee to be named as NPP Regional Awardee supported through a Committee Resolution which shall be officially endorsed to the DSWD Central Office.
- 5. Awarding of winners will be announced by the RIAC FF based on the agreed schedule and venue. All winners and finalists will be receiving their Certificate of Recognition and/or cash incentives based on the approved budget

- A write-up of not more than 1,000 words conformed/ signed by an authorized/designated representative of the family;
- Three (3) recommendations from the Barangay/credible source (local officials, parish church, any authorized/credible organizations);
- Photos of the family and their activities (family reunions, school, and other extra-curricular activities), and
- A maximum of 4-minute video (with link) summarizing what the family is all about

The set deadline for the submission of nomination is <u>until 29 October 2024</u>. Attached is the signed copy of the guidelines of the Regional Search for your reference.
