The following researches are qualified for the poster presentation. Poster Presentation participants are eligible to win awards such as "Best Poster Presentation", among others.

The poster presentation shall be be judged with the following general criteria:

Presentation Skills: Involves completing the presentation within the allocated time while effectively communicating the significance of your research, newly acquired knowledge, and personal achievements. It's crucial to use visual aids, such as diagrams or flowcharts, to ensure clarity and comprehensibility, enabling a clear explanation of concepts.

Research Competence: Emphasizes the importance of a coherent research flow that logically progresses through the background (introduction), methodology (materials and methods), results, and discussion. The experiments conducted should be appropriate for testing the hypotheses, with sound results that clearly present data through numbers or images. Additionally, logical reasoning is vital in the discussion, where the results are interpreted in light of prior knowledge and findings from other experiments.

**Enthusiasm:** Highlights the researcher's personal investment in the questions and challenges posed by the research theme, making the research a personal endeavor. The presenter should also show a keen interest in contemplating the next steps of the research. Originality is valued, with the research and its perspective reflecting the presenter's unique viewpoint.






## How to create your Tabletop Poster Display
