#### ADMINISTRATION OF THE NATIONAL CAREER ASSESSMENT EXAMINATION

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisors
Education Program Supervisors
Public Schools District Supervisors
All Public and Private Junior High School Principals
All Others Concerned

- In reference to DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2016, titled "Policy Guidelines on the National Assessment of Student Learning for the K to 12 Basic Education Program" and DepEd Memorandum No. 031, s. 2024 titled "Administration of the National Career Assessment Examination (NCAE) for the School Year 2024-2025", this Office, through the Schools Governance and Operations Division-School Management, Monitoring, and Evaluation Section shall administer the NCAE to all Grade 10 learners, both public and private on August 14-15, 2024.
- 2. The NCAE shall be administered in two (2) consecutive days through a paper-based modality to all currently enrolled Grade 10 learners as of August 9, 2024.
- 3. The NCAE is designed to provide guidance to individual learners for their future educational and career choices and to provide a basis for profiling learners' aptitude in the four senior high school (SHS) Tracks: Academic, Technical-Vocational-Livelihood, Sports, and Arts and Design. The results of the NCAE are utilized to support the national framework on career guidance and for entry assessment to the specific SHS tracks/strands in all public and private schools.
- 4. The NCAE assessment covers the following domains: General Scholastic Aptitude (GSA), Academic Track, and Occupational Interest Inventory (OII). The GSA covers Reading Comprehension, Mathematical Ability, Verbal Ability, Scientific Ability, and Logical Reasoning Ability. The Aptitude for SHS Tracks contains: (a) Academic, which includes Humanities and Social Sciences (HUMSS), Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM), and Accountancy Business and Management (ABM); (b) Technical Vocational-Livelihood (TVL); (c) Sports; and (d) Arts and Design. The OII is an inventory/checklist of occupational interests which provides an assessment on inclinations/preferences for comprehensive career guidance.
- Test accommodations shall be given to learners with disabilities (LWDs) who will be participating in the assessment activity following the provision stated in Section 9 of DO 55, s. 2016.

- 6. The test booklets (TBs) are **reusable** and may be reallocated within the Division should there be insufficiency. This means that a school may borrow TBs from schools within the Division and must returned the borrowed TBs to its original box. Photocopying of the TB and Answer Sheet (AS) is not allowed.
- 7. The testing materials will be distributed at SDO Bataan's Bulwagan ng mga Bayani at Banal on August 14, 2024, and shall be retrieved on August 15, 2024. The schedule below must be followed for both public and private schools.

- 9. Expenses to be incurred during the administration of NCAE will be charged to the program support funds to be downloaded to the Schools Division Office (SDO). Meanwhile, travel expenses relative to the conduct of the orientation shall be charged against School MOOE and other local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 10. The Public Schools District Supervisors and SGOD Personnel shall monitor the conduct of the NCAE. (See Enclosure 2. List of Monitors)
- 11. This Memorandum shall serve as Travel Authority of all concerned.

12. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is enjoined.
