**TRAINING ON STRENGTHENING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF NATIONAL
LEARNING CAMP ASSESSMENT**

1. In reference to DepEd Order 55, s. 2016 titled "Policy Guidelines on Assessment of Student Learning for the K to 12 Basic Education Program," this Office announces the conduct of Division Training on Strengthening the Implementation of National Learning Camp Assessment (NLCA) on **August 19-20, 2024**, at the venue to be announced through a separate memorandum.
2. Assessment is the process of measuring learners' progress in the attainment of learning standards and 21st century skills. The results of the various forms of assessment shall be used to quantify judgments on learners' academic performance. At the end of this activity, the following objectives shall be met:
 - a. equip school leaders in strengthening the implementation of NLCA by providing assessment results and technical assistance to improve the delivery of educational services;
 - b. ensure that the national learning camp assessment and subsequent program reviews address disparities in educational access and outcomes among different demographic groups, including marginalized communities and students with special needs;
 - c. provide opportunities for professional development for educators based on the findings of assessments and reviews including training in best practices identified through benchmarking and supporting educators in implementing new strategies effectively; and
 - d. establish mechanisms for ongoing monitoring and evaluation to track the implementation of improvements identified through the initiative.
3. The participants to the training are the Assistant Schools Division Superintendent, Chief Education Supervisors (SGOD and CID), Education Program Supervisors (SGOD, English, Math, and Science), Public Junior High School Principals, select SGOD Personnel and Program Management Team, see Enclosure 1. List of Participants.



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4. Expenses relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged to the Program Support Fund downloaded to this Division, meanwhile, travel and other related costs shall be charged against school MOOE and other local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing procedures.
5. This Memorandum shall serve as travel authority of the participants.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is enjoined.
