

DESIGNATION OF PARTNERSHIP FOCAL PERSON AT THE SCHOOL LEVEL

To:

Schools Division Superintendents

Chiefs, School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD)

Division Partnership Focal Persons Public School Principals/Heads

All Others Concerned

- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 40 s, 2015, titled "Guideline on K to 12 Partnerships".
- 2. At the school level, the Partnership Focal Person (PFP) shall be the school principal/head who shall carryout the partnership building activities of the school.
- 3. The Partnership Building Activity (PBA) shall be governed by existing laws and DepEd issuances such as but not limited to the following.
- 3.1 DepEd Order No. 40 s, 2012 "Child Protection Policy"- Policy and Guidelines on Protecting Children in School from Abuse, Violence, Exploitation, Discrimination, Bullying and other forms of Abuse;
- 3.2 DepEd Order No 55 s, 2013 "Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 10627, the Anti-Bullying Act of 2013;
- 3.3 Republic Act No. 7877, an Act of Declaring Sexual Harassment Unlawful in the Employment, Education or Training Environment and for Other Purposes:
- 3.4 DepEd Order No. 6 s, 2012 which expressly prohibits all forms and manner of cooperation or partnership with the tobacco industry in all areas of the country:
- 3.5 DepEd Order No 80 s, 2012 titled "Strengthening the integration of breastfeeding education in the curriculum, setting up and sustaining the operation of lactation stations in compliance with Executive Order No. 51", school officials are discouraged from partnering with companies manufacturing milk and infant formula products;
- 3.6 DepEd Order No. 39 s, 2009 on the commercialization of schools also expressly prohibits the appearance of any form of institutional endorsement by the DepEd for any commercial product or service within the school premises in exchange for any school-industry partnership;
- 3.7 Republic Act No. 8525- Adopt-A-School Act of 1998 and related DepEd issuances for corporate donations;
- 3.8 Relevant labor laws and issuances especially in the fields of internship, apprenticeships, on-the-job-training (OJT) and others;
