In light of this important event, the Schools Division Office of Bataan is excited to announce our plans to celebrate World Teachers' Day with engaging and meaningful activities designed to recognize and appreciate our educators.

3. The activity aims to create a memorable experience highlighting our teaching staff's achievements and talents.
4. The activities for the 2024 Pagpapahalaga sa mga Guro: Gawad Tanglaw at Talento are as follows:

Contest Guidelines and Mechanics

1. The Video Tribute Contest contest aims to highlight teachers' dedication, creativity, and positive influence on students.
2. One (1) entry per School is allowed.
3. The video should run for a minimum of 3 minutes and a maximum of 4 minutes.
4. The video must have a title.
5. The video must not contain any malicious or offensive content.
6. Content must focus on celebrating and acknowledging teachers' impact and contributions.
7. The video must be encoded on a commonly known video file compression/format such as .mp4, .avi, and .mkv.
8. If the link is broken/defective or not accessible, the submitted entry will no longer be included in the competition.
9. Copyright Compliance: Ensure that all music, images, and content used in the video are either original or properly licensed. Videos containing copyrighted material without proper authorization will be disqualified if restricted by Facebook due to copyright infringement.



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10. File name format should follow VideoTribute_SCHOOL_TITLE.
(VideoTribute _Elementary School_WALANGIWANAN)
11. Videos should be uploaded to a designated platform OneDrive and the link sent to <https://tinyurl.com/PAGPAPAHALAGASAMGAGURO>.
11. Upon joining the contest, student contestants who are over 18 years of age, or their parents, guardians, or caregivers, if they are minors, consent to the use of their personal information as included in the outputs that they will submit for purposes of publication if they are declared as winners, consistent with the provision of the Data Privacy Act.
12. All entries shall be considered property of the SDO BATAAN and maybe used for publication and any other legal purpose.
13. Upon joining the contest, student contestants who are over 18 years of age, or their parents, guardians, or caregivers, if they are minors, consent to the use of their personal information as included in the outputs that they will submit for purposes of publication if they are declared as winners, consistent with the provision of the Data Privacy Act.
14. SDO Bataan shall not be liable for any infringement of any intellectual property rights arising from the use of the entries. In case there are third-party claims of such infringement of any intellectual property rights, the contestants hold SDO Bataan free and harmless against such claims.
15. The participants of the Top 3 winning entries will receive a certificate of recognition on the other hand, non-winning participants will receive a certificate of participation.
16. The winners will be notified through the Division Memorandum.
17. Non-compliance with any of the stated contest rules and mechanics is a ground for disqualification.
18. The awarding ceremony will be conducted on October 3, 2024, during the 2024 Pagpapahalaga sa mga Guro: Gawad Tanglaw at Talento.
19. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.

Documents Needed for Submission for Gawad TANGLAW

1. Nomination Form

- Completed nomination form with details of the teacher adviser's service history, achievements, and contributions.

2. Letter of Recommendation

- A letter from the school principal or a senior official, detailing the nominee's accomplishments, impact, and long-term service.



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3. Service Record

- A record or summary of the teacher adviser's years of service, including any relevant teaching roles, subjects, and extracurricular activities.

4. Impact Statements

- Statements or testimonials from colleagues, students, and parents highlighting the nominee's positive influence on students and the school community.

5. Professional Development Records

- Documentation of any professional development activities, workshops, or training attended by the nominee.

6. Innovative Practices Report

- A brief report or description of any innovative methods or programs implemented by the nominee that have enhanced the educational experience for students.

7. Supporting Evidence

- Any additional evidence, such as awards, recognitions, or media coverage, that supports the nominee's achievements and contributions.

Submission Process:

- All documents must be submitted on or before October 1, 2024.
- The completed nomination package should be delivered to Bulwagan ng mga Bayani at Banal, SDO Bataan, Kabukiran, Calaylayan, Abucay, Bataan.
