COUNCIL CHAIRPERSONS AND COUNCIL SCOUT COMMISSIONER

SUBJECT: 14TH CENTRAL LUZON REGIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE

1. The Regional Coordination Office of the Central Luzon Region (CLR), BSP, is pleased to announce the conduct of its 14TH CENTRAL LUZON REGIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE, upon the approval of the CLR Regional Scout Committee, with the concurrence of all Council Scout Executives in the Region, to be held at Brgy. Alion, Mariveles, Bataan on December 11 – 15, 2024, with the Theme: "Ready for Life: Scouts for Peace and Sustainable Development", which will be hosted by the Bataan Council, BSP, in partnership and collaboration with the Barangay Alion, and LGU Mariveles, Bataan.

2. Jamboree Aim and Objectives:

The 14th Central Luzon Regional Scout Jamboree aims to provide a progressive, exciting, challenging, safe, and enjoyable learning environment for the Scouts to enhance their full Social, Physical, Intellectual, Character, Emotional, and Spiritual potentials as active citizens making real contributions in creating a better community.

At the end of the Regional Jamboree, the participants should be able to:

- Promote Scouting's values and educational initiatives that are faithful to its Vision, Mission, Fundamental Principles, and Methods and adapted to the needs, wants, interests and aspirations of young people;
- Conduct community service projects related to the thrusts of Scouting's Four (4) Thematic Areas of Education for Sustainable Development (1) Environment and Sustainability, (2) Peace and Community Engagement, (3) Skills for Life, and (4) Health and Well-Being;
- 3. Undertake high-adventure and outdoor activities that promote active and healthy lifestyles and appreciation of nature and the environment;
- Complete and satisfy the requirements for selected Merit Badges and Scout Ranks under the revised Advancement Scheme and Merit Badge System;
- Acquire and develop core life skills and 21st-century leadership capabilities through team building, cooperative learning, group dynamics, creative problem-solving, and decisionmaking skills;
- Increase the level of awareness and understanding about the prevailing issues on the
 environment, human rights, mental health and well-being, education, culture, and science
 and technology through the Global Development Village, City of Science and Cross Roads
 of Cultures; and
- 7. Promote Sustainable Development Goals and best practices through Modules and Educational Initiatives in Scouting.

3. Jamboree Participation. The following are the qualifications for all participating Scouts and Adult Leaders;

a. For Boy Scouts and Senior Scouts

- 1. Must be currently registered as Boy and/or Senior Scout with a Troop or Outfit;
- 2. Must be physically fit to undergo strenuous outdoor activities as certified by a licensed Physician:
- 3. Must be between nine (9) to twelve (12) years old for Boy Scouts;
- 4. Must be between thirteen (13) to eighteen (18) years old for Senior Scouts;
- 5. Must have secured his/her Parent's or Guardian's Permit
- 6. Must have his/her Camping Gear and Equipment
- 7. Shows leadership potential in his/her Troop/Outfit, preferably a graduate of PLTC/CLTC

b. For Rover Scouts

- 1. Must be currently registered as Rover Scout with a Rover Circle in good standing;
- 2. Must be between eighteen (18) to twenty-six (26) years old.
- Must be physically fit to undergo strenuous outdoor activities as certified by a licensed Physician;
- 4. Must have his/her own Camping Gears and Equipment; and
- 5. Must be willing to serve in various Jamboree Support Services in the areas of Program, Administration and Logistics.

c. For Adult Unit Leaders

- Must be a person of Good Moral Character;
- 2. Must be currently registered as Troop Leader, Outfit Advisor or Rover Leader;
- 3. Must be physically fit as certified by a Licensed Physician;
- 4. Must be a graduate of Basic Training Course for Unit Leaders;
- 5. Preferably a Wood Badge Holder; and
- 6. Must have his/her own Camping Gears and Equipment.

d. For Council Contingent Management Team

Each Local Council is expected to organize their respective Contingent Management Team to lead the smooth and orderly participation of their Contingents having the following positions:

- 1. Contingent Head
- 2. Deputy Contingent Head for Program
- 3. Deputy Contingent Head for Administration
- 4. Special Events and Activities Officer
- 5. Health and Safety Officer
- 6. Transportation and Communication Officer
- 7. Logistics and Supplies Officer
- 8. Physical Arrangement Officer
- 9. Mess and Catering Officer
- 10. General Services Support Staff
- e. For Regional Service Team. The Regional Service Team is composed of volunteers and lay leaders who will help the in planning, organizing and implementing various jamboree services including the Jamboree Programme and Administration.
 - 1. Must be a person of Good Moral Character;
 - 2. Must currently registered with the Local Council;
 - 3. Must be at least a Wood Badge Holder;
 - 4. Must by physically fit as certified by a Licensed Physician;
 - 5. Must have his/her own camping gears and equipment; and
 - Must have completed the Safe from Harm Online Course at https://www.scout.org/what-we-do/member-organizations/child-and-vouthsafety

4. Jamboree Registration Details.

- a. Registration Fee. A registration fee of Seven Hundred Pesos (Php. 700.00) shall be charged from each participant to cover the Jamboree Program Materials, and Souvenirs Items and to defray administrative costs and other operating expenses. Jamboree is not refundable but is transferable.
- b. Deadline for Registration. The deadline for payment for the Jamboree Registration Fee must be paid to Bataan Council BSP, on or before November 15, 2024, together with the attached Roster of Jamboree Participants must be submitted to the host Council copy furnished to the Regional Coordination Office.
- c. Mode of Payment. Payment shall be made thru Bank Deposit Only, upon the approval and confirmation of participation. NO Cash registration onsite. The official bank account details of the Host Council are as follows:
