Attached separate one File Scanned in PDF Format all the pertinent documents following the criteria for the arrangement of the files.

- A.3. For the search for Outstanding Innovation; Submit letter of intent sign by the immediate senior supervisor (school head/principal/dean). Provide a detailed description of the innovative project or initiative, including its objectives, implementation process, outcomes, and impact on students, colleagues, and the community. In narrative form (PDF Form, Bookman Old Style-Letter, A4 Size Paper, Affix Specimen Signature). Submit 1 file PDF File format your innovation proposal and accomplishment report.

**B. Submission Process:**

- B.1. Applications must be submitted online through the Link posted on the official HETTOP FB Group Page or HETTOP Application Form (Google Form).  
B.2. Ensure all required fields are completed accurately and all supporting materials are uploaded as specified.  
B.3. Applications must be submitted by the designated deadline to be considered for the award.

**C. Review and Evaluation:**

- C.1. Applications will be reviewed by a panel of evaluators consisting of education experts, practitioners, and industry professionals.  
C.2. Applications will be evaluated based on criteria provided.  
C.3. Evaluators may conduct interviews or request additional information from shortlisted applicants for further evaluation, if may arise for some clarifications.

**D. Notification and Recognition:**

- D.1. Shortlisted applicants will be notified and may be invited to present their projects or initiatives to the judging panel.  
D.2. Winners will be announced publicly through the social media channels, and other communication channels.  
D.3. Winners will receive a certificate of recognition during the socialization nights and may be featured in HETTOP FB Group Page.

**E. Disqualification:**

- E.1. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.  
E.2. Applications that do not meet the eligibility criteria or provide insufficient information may be disqualified.  
E.3. Plagiarism or misrepresentation of information will result in immediate disqualification.
