A.3. For the search for Outstanding Innovation; Submit letter of intent sign by the immediate senior supervisor (school head/principal/dean). Provide a detailed description of the innovative project or initiative, including its objectives, implementation process, outcomes, and impact on students, colleagues, and the community. In narrative form (PDF Form, Bookman Old Style-Letter, A4 Size Paper, Affix Specimen Signature). Submit 1 file PDF File format your innovation proposal and accomplishment report.

#### **B. Submission Process:**

- B.1. Applications must be submitted online through the Link posted on the official HETTOP FB Group Page or HETTOP Application Form (Google Form).
- B.2. Ensure all required fields are completed accurately and all supporting materials are uploaded as specified.
- B.3. Applications must be submitted by the designated deadline to be considered for the award.

#### C. Review and Evaluation:

- C.1 Applications will be reviewed by a panel of evaluators consisting of education experts, practitioners, and industry professionals.
- C.2. Applications will be evaluated based on criteria provided.
- C.3. Evaluators may conduct interviews or request additional information from shortlisted applicants for further evaluation, if may arise for some clarifications.

#### D. Notification and Recognition:

- D.1. Shortlisted applicants will be notified and may be invited to present their projects or initiatives to the judging panel.
- D.2. Winners will be announced publicly through the social media channels, and other communication channels.
- D.3. Winners will receive a certificate of recognition during the socialization nights and may be featured in HETTOP FB Group Page.
