<u>Kwentong Bayani: Inter-School Literary Competition</u> (Story-Telling)

December 9, 2024 | 10:00 – 12:00 NN BHC Conference Room

Contest Mechanics:

- 1. Each invited school can register only one team composed of one (1) **Grade 6 student**. The student shall be accompanied by one (1) faculty as coach.
- 2. Only registered teams will be allowed to compete.
- 3. Registrations shall be done by filling out an online form. Interested schools may get the link to the form by contacting BHC on 0909-4760-923 / 0927-9297-195.
- 4. Upon registration, a copy of the story shall be send to the participating schools.
- 5. This contest allows learner-participant to demonstrate their interpretive skills and ability to communicate using effective verbal and non-verbal cues in reading a story aloud to an audience.
- 6. Only the first 10 Private/Public schools to register will be included in the competition.
- 7. The participants shall be given (15) minutes to study the story then they shall read the story creatively and dramatically which shall not exceed five minutes.
- 8. The timekeepers will signal when the story-telling reaches the 4-minute and 5-minute mark. Exceeding the time will result in point deductions.
- 9. Registration is until November 20, 2024.
- 10. The contest proper will be on December 9, 2024 at 10:00 am in the BHC Conference
- 11. The judging criteria shall be based on the following:

Criteria	Percentage
 Oral interpretation Read aloud accurately the message or theme, emotions, mood, character and all the other elements of the story. Establish creative and dramatic impact throughout the presentation. 	40%
Voice projection Speak clearly, distinctly and with appropriate and varied pauses, pitch and tone modulation. Recite loudly enough for the audience to hear	30%
Stage Presence • Show confidence and appropriate posture or projection, facial expressions and gestures	20%
Adherence to the rules Time management and compliance with the guidelines	10%
Total	100%

December 9, 2024 | 1:00 – 3:00 PM BHC Conference Room

Contest Mechanics:

- 1. Each invited school can register only one team composed of one (1) **Grade 10 student**. The student shall be accompanied by one (1) faculty as coach.
- 2. Only registered teams will be allowed to compete.
- 3. Registrations shall be done by filling out an online form. Interested schools may get the link to the form by contacting BHC on 0909-4760-923 / 0927-9297-195.
- 4. Only the first 10 Private/Public schools to register will be included in the competition.
- 5. The topic will be Celebrating Diversity, Empowering Community Action
- 6. The speech should be delivered in a **maximum of 5 minutes**, more than the time, 2 points will be deducted.
- 7. The structure of the speech is composed of the following:

Introduction: Clear and engaging opening

Body: Logical and coherent argument or narrative

Conclusion: Strong and notable closing

- 8. The participants may use notes. However, they should demonstrate a strong command of their material without heavy reliance on notes.
- 9. The speech should be delivered in **English**. Clear pronunciation, appropriate pace, and effective use of pauses are required.
- 10. The participant should wear school uniform.
- 11. The participants are expected to be respectful and always show professional behavior. Disruptive or inappropriate conduct will result in disqualification.
- 12. The timekeepers will signal when the speech reaches the 4-minute and 5-minute mark. Exceeding the time will result in point deductions.
- 13. Registration is until November 20, 2024.
- 14. The contest proper will be on December 9, 2024 at 1:00 pm in the BHC Conference Hall.
- 15. The judging criteria shall be based on the following:

Criteria	Percentage
Content Relevance, organization, clarity of message and evidence and sample	40%
Delivery Voice, Pace, Pronunciation and enunciation, Eye contact and body language	40%
Originality Creativity and persuasiveness	10%
Adherence to the rules Time management and compliance with the guidelines	10%
Total	100%

<u>Indak Bayani Inter-School Group Dance Competition</u> (Modern Cultural Dance)

December 9, 2024 | 3:00 – 6:00 PM Bataan Heroes College School Grounds

Contest Mechanics:

- 1. Each team must be composed of a minimum of **10** members to a maximum of **15** members. All members should be bona fide **Grade 12 students** of the school they are representing.
- 2. Only one music shall be used by all competing teams. The official dance track will be exclusively provided by the Committee on Competition and shall be used during the actual day of the Inter-School Group Dance Competition. The team shall use the original dance track provided for their practice.
- 3. The official track will be provided upon registration. Only the **first 10 Private/Public schools to register** will be included in the competition.
- 4. Registrations shall be done by filling out an online form. Interested schools may get the link to the form by contacting BHC on 0909-4760-923 / 0927-9297-195.
- 5. Invited schools can register only one (1) team.
- 6. Lifting and pyramid stunts are not allowed. In case of violation, the team will be given a five (5) points deduction from the overall score (to be deducted by the committee.)
- 7. Competing teams are allowed to use appropriate costumes. Teams with costumes that are too revealing will not be allowed to compete.
- 8. For safety purposes, props and any other materials hazardous to the venue and event (such as fire, bladed weapons, ammunitions, etc.) are strictly <u>NOT</u> allowed.
- 9. Any lack or excess in the number of required members shall have an equivalent deduction of five (5) points per person (to be deducted by the committee.)
- 10. Registration is until November 20, 2024.
- 11. The judging criteria shall be based on the following:

Criteria	Percentage
Costume and Presentation Appropriateness, originality, aesthetics, and effectiveness of costume to the dance routine	15%
Synchronization and Coordination Synchronization and "neatness" of the routine, as well as coordination during formations and transitions	30%
Creativity and Choreography Originality, pleasantness of transitions, flow of choreography, effectiveness of dance moves, complementariness to the beat of the music, use of different formations	30%
Overall Performance The general overall look, execution, attitude, crowd response, and energy of the group throughout the performance	25%
Total	100%
