2024 DIVISION PAWIKAN QUIZ BEE

GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

- Each district will send two (2) contestants from Grade 6 who are bonafide pupils of public schools and one (1) contestant from Grade 6 in all private elementary schools. In the junior high school category, one (1) contestant per school from Grade 9 will be sent, while senior high schools will send one (1) contestant from either Grade 11 or Grade 12, who are bonafide students of both private and public high schools.
- 2. The in-person quiz bee will be held on December 4, 2024 (Wednesday) from 8:30 AM to 11:30 AM for the Elementary Level, and on December 5, 2024 (Thursday) from 8:30 AM to 11:30 AM for Junior High School and from 1:00 PM to 4:30 PM for Senior High School. The venue for this activity will be at the Emiliana Hall, City of Balanga, Bataan.
- 3. There will be easy, average, and difficult rounds. The scoring is as follows:

Easy: one (1) point Average: two (2) points Difficult: three (3) points

4. The ten (10) test questions per category of the Pawikan Quiz Bee will come from the

following areas: Part I: Ecosystem Part II: Marine Life Part III: Pawikan

- 5. The contestant with the highest number of correct answers will be declared the champion, the second highest will take second place, and the third highest will take third place. In case of a tie, a tie-breaker question will be provided during the clincher round.
- In case of a protest, only the official participants are allowed to raise their inquiries as early as possible during the contest, addressed to the chairperson of the Board of Judges.
- 7. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.
- 8. a. Certificates of Recognition and prizes will be awarded as follows:

Second Place: Php 1,500.00 Php 1,500.00
Third Place: Php 1,000.00 Php 1,000.00

b. Certificates of Participation will be given to all students and teacher-coaches.

MECHANICS PAWIKAN HAT MAKING COMPETITION December 07, 2024

Theme: KaBATAAN: Kabalikat sa Pag-aalaga ng Pawikan

Contest Guidelines:

- Participants will create unique and creative hats inspired by pawikan (sea turtles) to raise awareness
 about marine conservation and the importance of protecting these remarkable creatures.
- 2. The contest is open to all ages in junior high school and senior high school. There shall be only one (1) design and one student designer **per school**.
- 3. Participating student designers should be duly endorsed by their respective school principals. The endorsement shall contain the following information:
 - Full name and current grade of student designer
 - Concept for the hat design. This shall be a brief description for the idea for the hat design, which includes, but are not limited to: (1) materials to be used, (2) prominent colors to be used, (3) other design eliminates and iconography to be featured.

The endorsement shall be submitted on or before November 25, 2024. Incomplete endorsements shall not be counted as official entries. The endorsement shall be submitted to tourism@bataan.gov.ph with the subject Pawikan Hat Making Competition 2024. Endorsements submitted after the deadline, or incomplete endorsement after the deadline shall not be considered.

- 4. Participants may use a variety of materials to create their hats, including but not limited to: paper, fabric, cardboard, paint, recyclable materials. All materials must be safe and non-toxic.
- 5. The pawikan hat should be worn by the participating school during the Walk for a Cause on December 7, 2024, 5:00 AM. Each school should have a minimum of 10 persons wearing the pawikan hat, including the student designer. The worn pawikan hat should have the same design.
- 6. Judging will be on December 7, 2024 during the Walk for a Cause.
