

- 2. The Department of Education (DepEd) is one with the Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC), the National Youth Commission (NYC), the Department of Social Welfare and Development Council (DSWD), Local Government Units (LGUs) and Private and Civil Society Organizations in celebration of 32nd National Children's Month anchored to the theme "Break the Prevalence, End the Violence: Protection Children, Creating a Safe Philippines".
- 3. This year's National Children's Month celebration shall highlight on the prevention and addressing Violence Against Children (VAC). In addition, it shall cover the four categories of children's rights to wit:
 - 3.1 Survival Rights (1st Week of November)



Contest Guidelines and Mechanics

- 1. On the Spot Poster Making Contest is a face to face competition. Theme for the contest shall be given on the day of the competition.
- 2. One (1) student-participant per Division is allowed.
- 3. Participants are given 3 hours to finish their outputs.
- 4. Learner-participant shall be accompanied by one coach. However, coaches are only allowed to assist the learner during the setting up of materials on the day of the competition
- 5. Participants shall provide all the material needed in the contest and must use the white background in vertical background/orientation.
- 6. The medium for visual artistry shall only be limited to oil pastel and shall be provided by the organizer.

- 7. Participants are not allowed to bring pictures or images for reference during the contest.
- 10. The poster must be original. If the submitted poster is found to have been plagiarized, it will be disqualified from the competition.
- 11. The contestants and coaches of the Top 3 winning posters will receive a cash prize and Certificate of Recognition and non-winning participants shall receive certificate of participation and consolation cash prize.

Cash Prize for Poster Making Contest

- 12. The winners shall be announced after the contest and issue a Regional Memorandum.
- 13. All entries shall be considered property of the DepEd RO III and may be used for publication and any other legal purpose.
- 14. Upon joining the contest, leraner contestants who are over 18 years of age, or their parents, guardians, or caregivers, if they are minors, consent to the use of their personal information as included in the outputs that they will submit for purposes of publication if they be declared as winners, consistent with the provision of the Data Privacy Act.
- 15. DepEd RO III shall not be liable for any infringement of any intellectual property rights arising from the use of the entries. In case there are third-party claims of such infringement of any intellectual property rights, the contestants hold DepEd RO III free and harmless against such claims.
- 16. Non-compliance with any of the stated contest rules and mechanics is a ground for disqualification.
- 17. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.
