ATTENDANCE TO FLAG RAISING CEREMONY EVERY MONDAY OR THE PRECEDING DAY IF MONDAY IS DECLARED A NON-WORKING HOLIDAY

- 1. In adherence to Republic Act No. 8491, otherwise known as the Flag and Heraldic Code of the Philippines, which prescribes the proper use, display, and respect of the Philippine flag, this Office reiterates the mandatory attendance to the Flag Raising Ceremony for all teaching and non-teaching personnel in public schools and the Schools Division Office of Bataan every Monday or the preceding working day if Monday is declared a non-working holiday.
- 2. Further, Section 18 of RA 8491 explicitly mandates the holding of flag ceremonies in all government offices, agencies, and instrumentalities. As public servants, we are called upon to instill and manifest patriotism and respect for the symbols of our country, particularly the national flag and anthem.
- 3. In recognition of the Constitutional provision on freedom of religion, those personnel belonging to religious groups that object to participating in flag ceremonies may request exemption.
- 4. In this regard, all public schools are directed to conduct the Flag Raising Ceremony at the specified time every Monday or as adjusted. The presence of all teaching and non-teaching personnel is mandatory, and attendance shall be strictly monitored by school heads and documented accordingly.
- 5. Non-compliance with this directive shall be subject to appropriate administrative actions as provided for under Civil Service Laws and Rules.
