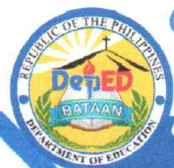

To recap on the Technology Innovation Plan Competition, here is the **criteria** and **sample format** on how each submission will be graded:

Maximum of 30 pages, including: Table of Contents, Title Page, and 1st page.

Font type: Times New Roman

Size: 12

Spacing: 1.5

- Project Context - 10 points
- Purpose of the Project - 10 points
- Project Description - 10 points
- Scope of the Study - 10 points
- Limitation of the Study - 10 points
- Methodology - 10 points
- Key highlights - 10 points
- Summary of Conclusion and Recommendation - 10 points

Competition Guidelines:

- 1. Original Content:** All submissions must be original. Avoid plagiarism, as ideas will be reviewed for authenticity.
- 2. Team Participation:** Students can work individually or in teams of up to 5 members. Collaboration is encouraged but not mandatory.
- 3. Submission Format:** The innovation plan word document should be submitted in PDF format. Ensure it includes clear sections for Title, Table of Contents, Project Context, Purpose of the Project, Project Description, Scope of the Study, Methodology, Limitations of the Study, Key Highlights, Summary of Conclusion and Recommendations.
- 4. Page Limit:** The document must not exceed 30 pages.
- 5. Submission Method:** Email your submissions to japrogramassistant5@gmail.com with the subject line: *[Team Name] School Name - Tech Innovation Plan*.
- 6. Judging Focus:** Plans will be evaluated based on creativity, feasibility, practicality, relevance, and impact on the community.
- 7. Theme:** Focus on tech-driven solutions to improve daily life or address pressing societal issues.
- 8. Deadline:** Submit your Tech Innovation Plan on or before **January 31, 2025**. Please make sure to not miss the deadline!

Prizes:

1st Place: 20,000

2nd Place: 10,000

3rd Place: 5,000

Remember, active engagement could also lead to incredible prizes for the schools! Please see below:

- The school with the most participants will be granted PHP20,000 worth of items for school improvements
