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4. Interested teacher-applicants must submit their pertinent documents, including the following, to their respective SDOs:

- a. Updated Personal Data Sheet (CSC Form No. 212);



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b. 1,500-word essay written by the applicant on why he/she should receive the Award; and

c. Accomplished Matrix (See **Annex B** for the Template) of the applicant's relevant activities, engagements, awards, and accomplishments with supporting documents (complete names of event organizers and training topics/ subjects; training certificates need not be submitted).

5. The SDOs shall then endorse their screened nominees to the RO, accompanied by a *Letter of Nomination* duly signed by the Schools Division Superintendent addressed to the Regional Director.

6. **The deadline for the submission of SDO nominations to the RO is January 2, 2025. The Letter of Nomination and all pertinent documents enumerated in paragraph 4 (a-c) shall be arranged chronologically and uploaded in a single PDF file through the link [tinyurl.com/2025PMCA](https://tinyurl.com/2025PMCA). Submission of hard copies of nomination documents is not required.**

7. The RO PRAISE Committee chaired by the Assistant Regional Director shall further evaluate the nominees endorsed by the SDOs and shall select and submit the RO nominee, along with the nominee's requirements and *Letter of Nomination* duly signed by the Regional Director, to DepEd ICO through email [ico@deped.gov.ph](mailto:ico@deped.gov.ph) (copy furnished [neap.od@deped.gov.ph](mailto:neap.od@deped.gov.ph)) on or before January 6, 2025, with the following instructions:

a. Email must have the subject line "Region 3- 2025 Princess Maha Chakri Award."

b. *Letter of Nomination* must be addressed to the DepEd Secretary, attention to ICO Assistant Secretary Georgina Ann H. Yang.

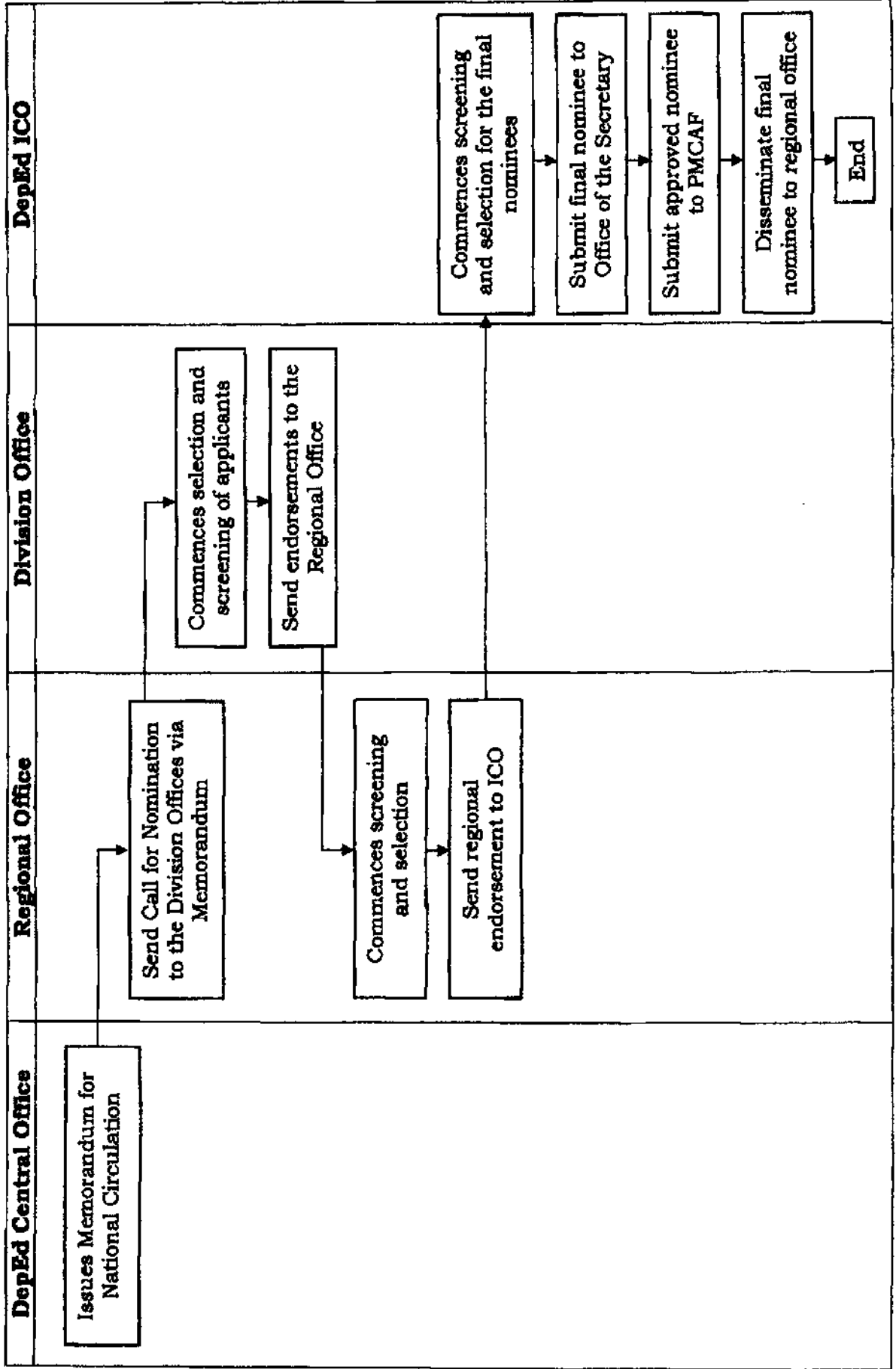
