CONDUCT OF TESDA FREE NATIONAL CERTIFICATION ASSESSMENT FOR SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS OF DEPED BATAAN

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Education Program Supervisors Public Schools District Supervisors Elementary and Secondary School Principals All Others Concerned

- Pursuant to the provisions outlined in the Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) Series of 2024 and TESDA Circular No. 45, s. 2024, this Office hereby announces the conduct of the TESDA Free National Certification Assessment for Senior High School (SHS) students enrolled in the Technical-Vocational Livelihood (TVL) track.
- 2. This initiative aims to:
 - ensure the high-quality assessment and certification of SHS-TVL learners, consistent with the guidelines set by TESDA;
 - **b.** provide learners with an opportunity to secure NCs that align with their TVL specializations; and
 - c. strengthen the employability of SHS-TVL graduates.
- 3. School Heads of Senior High Schools offering TVL tracks are directed to submit the list of SHS-TVL learners eligible for assessment, indicating their qualifications, along with the accomplished NC Application Forms and Self-Assessment Guides (SAGs) for each learner. These documents must be endorsed to the Division Office through the Education Program Supervisor in charge of Senior High Schools, who will then forward the compiled documents to the TESDA Provincial Office for scheduling and implementation of the assessment.
- 4. TESDA-certified assessors will conduct the competency assessment in adherence to TESDA standards, as detailed in the enclosed schedules and designated assessment venues. School Heads are responsible for ensuring compliance with the required documents and their timely submission, while the Division Office Senior High School Secretariat will oversee the process and provide technical assistance to guarantee smooth implementation.

- 5. The assessment will be offered to students free of charge, with costs chargeable to TESDA funds per TESDA Circular No. 45, s. 2024. However, any incidental expenses incurred by the student-assessees and Division/School personnel involved in the assessment, such as transportation and food, shall be charged to available funds, subject to established accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- **6.** This Memorandum also serves as the official travel authority for the attached list of student-assesses, their respective teacher-chaperones, and the Division Senior High School Secretariat.
- 7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is requested.

Things to bring and prepare:

- 1. School ID
- 2. Accomplished Application Form and Self-Assessment Guide (already submitted to SDO and forwarded to TESDA Assessment Center)
- 3. Tools and Equipment: (provided by the Assessment Center)
 - Hand tools (e.g., hoe, rake, shovel, pruning shears).
 - · Measuring tools (e.g., tape measure, graduated cylinder).
 - · Seeds or planting materials (if specified by the center).
 - Small containers for seed collection or samples.
- Notebook and black ballpen for note-taking.
- 5. Personal protective equipment (PPE).
 - Comfortable work clothes appropriate for agricultural work (e.g., longsleeved shirt and sturdy pants).
 - Durable, closed-toe work boots or safety shoes
 - · Wide-brim hat or cap for sun protection
 - Collared Shirt for Biometrics
 - · Gloves (rubber or fabric, depending on the tasks)
 - Safety goggles (for tasks involving machinery, pesticides, or fertilizers).
 - Mask or respirator (if pesticide application is included in the tasks).
 - · Raincoat or jacket (if the assessment might occur in rainy conditions).
- 6. Food and Hygiene Kit:
 - Snacks, Lunch, Water
 - · Soap, alcohol, or hand sanitizer.
 - · Clean towel.

Additional Tips

- 1. Review the TESDA Assessment Criteria: Familiarize yourself with the tasks and competencies to be assessed (e.g., planting, maintaining crops, harvesting, applying fertilizers, etc.).
- 2. Arrive Early: Allow time for registration and orientation.
- Follow Safety Guidelines: Demonstrate proper handling of tools and materials during the assessment.
