- 1. This is to announce the conduct of the Annual PSSPA III Convention entitled Beyond Leadership: School Heads Driving Academic Success, Enhancing Fiscal Management Skills in Line with COA Standards, and Promoting Mental Wellness. - 2. This convention aims to address crucial areas that shape effective and resilient school leadership, empowering school heads to navigate their roles in improving school performance and overall well-being. The key objectives include:
