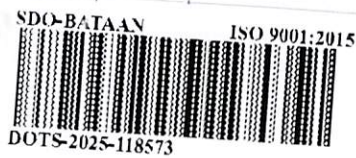

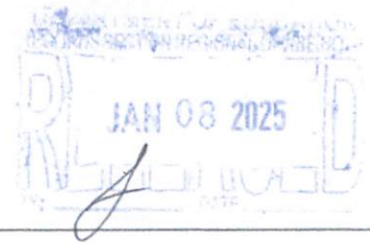

**CLAPSA ONE-DAY REGIONAL CONVENTION FOR PRIVATE SCHOOL HEADS AND ADMINISTRATORS**

To : Schools Division Superintendents

1. The **Central Luzon Association of Private School Administrators, Inc. (CLAPSA)** will hold a **One-Day Regional Convention for Private School Heads and Administrators** on January 31, 2025 at Widus Hotel Clark, Clark Freeport, Pampanga.
2. The convention will evolve around the theme: *“Visualizing the Future of Private Schools”* and its objectives include:
  - a. To gather private schools administrators across the different DepEd Divisions of Region III and discuss issues and concerns relevant to private school operation;

4. Convention fee of Two Thousand Five HUNDRED Pesos (Php2,500.00) will be charged each participant and it covers payment of convention kit, food (morning snacks, lunch, and afternoon snacks), certificate and venue.
