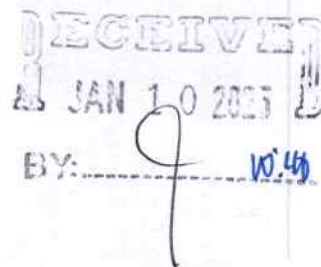



EcoVerse: Framing Nature's Beauty Through Words and Lenses PHOTOJOURNALISM CONTEST

I. Objectives

As we celebrate the 19th foundation day of Colegio de San Juan de Letran Bataan, *EcoVerse: Framing Nature's Beauty Through Words and Lenses* integrates environmental awareness and celebrates the 19th foundation day of the Colegio. This activity underscores our commitment to ecological stewardship and excellence. It specifically aims to:

1. Promote collaboration by encouraging participants to work together to showcase nature's beauty and sustainability.
2. Foster innovation in capturing and presenting creative perspectives of nature through photography and captions.
3. Raise environmental awareness to inspire a sense of responsibility and interconnectedness between humans and the natural world.

II. Guidelines, and Criteria for Judging

1. The competition is open to all Grade 10 and Grade 12 participants.
2. The competition has two categories: Filipino and English
3. Participants must bring their own photography devices, which can include but are not limited to phone cameras, digital cameras, DSLR cameras, and similar equipment.
4. The photograph must showcase the beauty of nature (e.g., plants, wildlife, landscapes) and sustainability, with an emphasis on "Care for Creation." Photos must be taken exclusively within the premises of the Colegio.
5. Participants will be given time during the event to write their captions (maximum of 50 characters) in either Filipino or English. Captions should align with the theme "EcoVerse: Framing Nature's Beauty Through Words and Lenses."
6. Participants will be provided with a link where they can upload their entries, including the photo and caption.
7. The photo must be the participant's original work. Basic editing such as cropping, color enhancement, and brightness/contrast adjustments is allowed. Composite images, heavy manipulation, graphic design elements, or the use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) tools are strictly prohibited.
8. Photos must not include watermarks, logos, or any identifying marks.
9. By submitting an entry, participants agree to allow the organizers to use their photographs for promotional purposes, with appropriate credit given. Any form of plagiarism or submission of non-original work will result in immediate disqualification.
10. Entries will be graded based on the following:

Criteria	Percentage
Relevance to the Theme	30%
Creativity and Originality	25%
Technical Quality	20%
Composition and Aesthetics	15%
Impact and Emotional Appeal	10%
TOTAL	100%



III. Awards and Recognition

Winners will receive *a cash prize and certificate of recognition*, and a *certificate of participation* will be given to all participants who competed in this event.
