GUIDELINES ON THE RECRUITMENT, SELECTION, AND APPOINTMENT TO HIGHER TEACHING POSITIONS

Assistant Schools Division Superintendent To: Chief Education Supervisors **Education Program Supervisors Public Schools District Supervisors** Elementary and Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned

- 1. In line with the Department of Education's (DepEd) issuance of the Guidelines on the Recruitment, Selection, and Appointment to Higher Teaching Positions in elementary, secondary, and senior high school levels as contained in DepEd Order No. 20, s. 2024, this Office enjoins all concerned personnel to familiarized themselves with the provisions of this new policy.
- 2. This Order introduces a systematic and competency-based approach to recruitment, selection, and appointment anchored on the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST) and aligned with the principles of merit, fitness, competence, equal opportunity, transparency, and accountability under the DepEd Merit Selection Plan (DepEd Order No. 019, s. 2022).
- 3. It is emphasized that the guidelines aim to ensure the delivery of quality, accessible, relevant, responsive, and inclusive basic education while addressing the challenges of the 21st century.
- 4. The following are the salient provisions under the said Order:
 - Systematic and competency-based process for the recruitment, assessment, selection, and appointment to higher teaching positions.
 - Revised criteria and point system aligned with applicable standards.
 - Repeal or amendment of provisions in previous DepEd issuances inconsistent with this new Order.
