REVISED GUIDELINES ON CLASS AND WORK SUSPENSION IN SCHOOLS **DURING DISASTERS AND EMERGENCIES**

In line with DepEd Order No. 022, s. 2024, the Department of Education has issued the Revised Guidelines on Class and Work Suspension in Schools During Disasters and Emergencies. These guidelines aim to ensure the safety and well-being of learners, teachers, and non-teaching personnel during natural or human-induced disasters while maintaining continuity in learning.

Key highlights of the guidelines include:

1. Class Suspension Protocols:

- In-person classes shall be suspended during disasters or emergencies to prevent harm to all school stakeholders.
- · Learners affected by such suspensions shall be given due consideration regarding attendance and the completion of learning tasks.

2. Work Suspension Protocols:

Suspension of work for teaching and non-teaching personnel may also be implemented based on the severity of the disaster or emergency.

3. Alignment with Existing Policies:

· All provisions inconsistent with this Order are repealed, rescinded, or modified accordingly.
