
# ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL ORDER FOR GRADUATION IN PRIVATE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOLS


To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Education Program Supervisors Public Schools District Supervisors Private School Administrators/ Principals All Others Concerned

- In view of Regional Memorandum No. 013, s. 2020 titled Reiteration of Policy Pertaining to Issuance of Special Order for Graduation, SDO Bataan, through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD), articulates the process, timelines, and activities concerning the issuance of Special Order for Graduation in Private Senior High Schools (SHSs).
- Furthermore, this Office informs all Private SHSs that the issuance of Special Order shall be processed and acted on in the Schools Division Office (SDO) and shall be forwarded to the Regional Office fifteen (15) calendar days before the end of the academic year.
- 3. Hence, Private SHSs shall prepare the following documentary requirements:
  - A. Letter of Intent addressed to the Regional Director thru the Schools Division Superintendent
  - B. List of Qualified Graduates
    - 1. Per class/section/ track/ strand/specialization
    - 2. Boys- 1st column, Numbered
    - 3. Girls 2<sup>nd</sup> column, Numbered
    - 4. Maximum of 50 students per application
    - 5. Family Name, First Name, Middle Name
    - 6. Certified True and Correct by the School Head
  - C. Accomplished SO Form
    - 1. Boys- 1<sup>st</sup> column, Numbered (Maximum of 25 learners)
    - 2. Girls- 2<sup>nd</sup> column, Numbered (Maximum of 25 learners)
    - 3. If the number of learners per column exceeds 25 learners, use additional page.
  - D. Original School Form 10- A (Permanent Record SHS Grades 11-12)
    - Full entry of Quarterly Grades and Final Grade for Grade 11, 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter Grades for Grade 12
    - 2. Certification of Eligibility signed by the School Head over Printed Name

- E. Form 9 (Graduation Form)
  - 1. Grade 11-1st and 2nd Semester Final Grades
  - 2. Grade 12- 1st Semester Final Grades
  - 3. Grade 12- 2nd Semester Third Quarter Grades
  - 4. Report of Completion of Work Immersion including No. of Hours Inclusive Dates, Business/ Industry Partner
- F. Original School Form 10 (Permanent Record Secondary -Grades 7-10)
- G. Photocopy of PSA or NSO Birth Certificate
- H. Certified true copy of SEC Registration
- I. Certified true copy of Government Permit

(Note: All forms should be printed on 8.5 X 13 paper. Softcopy of the List of Graduates, Form 9 and SO Form templates shall be provided in a link to be disseminated through Private Schools Official group.)

- 4. Application of private senior high schools for special order for graduation shall be approved and issued by the Regional Director.
- 5. Private Schools shall submit four (4) copies of accomplished SO Forms with one (1) set of documentary requirements in Yellow Expanding Folder with side tabbing (Attention: EPS, SGOD) three (3) days after the said documents have been checked and evaluated. Schools are also advised to prepare one (1) set of the same documents as receiving copy. Meanwhile, softcopy (in word file) of the final SO Form shall also be uploaded in the link to be provided by the EPS, SGOD.
- 6. Attached is the Schedule of Evaluation of SO Forms for reference and quidance.
- 7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.


