THE TEACHER SERVES AS A MODEL

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Teachers significantly influence how kids develop intellectually and in terms of conduct and character development (Ekmekci & Serrano, 2022). Teachers influence pupils differently; their influence transcends mere knowledge transfer (Löper, 2024). Student motivation, achievement, and persistence are strongly influenced by teacher quality—including motivation, qualifications, and practices; positive student attitudes and actions are much enhanced by the teacher's modeling of herself (Alomiear & Alreshidi, 2022). The need for teachers to function as models and the several elements affecting this responsibility are investigated in this essay.

The development of pupils' character and values depends on their teachers' ethical behavior and role modeling (Rahayu, 2023). Students' academic performance and achievements are highly influenced by the traits and actions of their teachers (Alomiear & Alreshidi, 2022). Furthermore, especially in inclusive classrooms (Ratna et al., 2022), the student-teacher connection is much improved by teachers' role model conduct. Teachers' gender can also influence pupils' cognitive and non-cognitive development, underlining their influence (Tanguay & Many, 2022).

The direct impact of teachers' performance and leadership styles on pupils' academic results is that the ability of new instructors to form relationships, effectively use digital resources, and track development will determine how they view their influence on student learning (Joonggeun & Song, 2021). Support and team teaching for student teachers help to shape their professional identity (Chen, 2023). Teachers' well-developed social-emotional competencies help create good student interactions and attitudes



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(Utama, 2022). Students' academic performance suffers less when teachers see constructivist learning theory favorably (Basnet & Sherpa, 2020).

Teachers' behavior and performance influence students' learning outcomes and behaviors (Smith, 2021). Kids' Success and achievements depend critically on their teachers' attitudes and job satisfaction (Willis et al., 2021). Teachers' social engagement during the COVID-19 epidemic improved students' academic engagement and behavior (Tambunan, 2021). The effective behaviors of expert teachers significantly affect student learning results. Teachers' performance in fostering resilience and literacy impacts student learning outcomes.

Teachers set a good example for their students, affecting their grades, attitudes, behavior, and growth. Realizing that teachers are role models is important for creating a good learning setting that helps students grow as whole people. Students' experiences and achievements are greatly affected by how good teachers are, how ethical they are, how they care for their students' health, how teachers lead, and how emotionally intelligent they are.

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
