<p>a. The "Tinikling " is a folkdance dance skills exhibition . Concept or theme for performance, costume, and props must be reflective and relevant to the folkdance festivals. Performance, costume, and props must be reflective and relevant to the folkdance</p> <p>b. The " Tinikling" shall have be a ;</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;">1 . Dance Exhibition - It is the full presentation of the group's dance performance.</p> <p>c. Only one (1) entry per school is allowed to Junior Public and Private High School with or without Special Program in the Arts. (SPA)</p> <p>d. A maximum of 8 dancers and 1 coach will be allowed per entry.</p> <p>e. The group may use the tinikling music during the dance exhibition, but the dance routines should be purely transformational in nature which is characterized by the use of dance steps and movements of tinikling dance.</p> <p>f. The following are strictly prohibited during the performances:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •tossing •lifting <p>g. Bamboo props shall be provided by the participants.</p>

VIII. Event Rules and Mechanics

- a. There will be one (1) entry per school. This is open to all public and private Junior High School with or without Special Program in the Arts (SPA)
- b. The group should be a composition of the following:
 - 16 to 20 members
 - No age restriction, provided that the members are existing students from Junior High School with or without SPA
 - One teacher/ coach conductor
 - One DepEd employee accompanist
- c. The contestants shall bring the certification of enrollment duly signed by the school principal or registrar.
- d. The group shall sing one (1) contest piece song, Bataan, Bayani at Banal.
- e. Contest piece shall be provided by the Provincial Tourism Office.
- f. The groups are encouraged to wear any appropriate attire without any distinguish identification of the School.
- g. Contest piece shall be sung as straight singing with recorded or live accompaniment.
