This is in reference to the **DepEd Memorandum No. 022, s. 2021** entitled *Observance of National Celebrations on Advocacy Programs in Support to Inclusive Education*, relative to the conduct of the **2025 National Intellectual Disability Week** with the theme *Ang Inclusion ay Pag-ibig* from **February 14 to 20, 2025**.

This Department encourages all schools especially those with Special Needs Education (SNED) programs to conduct any of the following suggested school-based activities during the week:

- a. Inviting the public to visit schools and classes or other educational service providers for children and youth with intellectual disabilities;
- b. Holding cultural shows, sports fest, photo and work exhibits, advocacy campaigns in radio and television shows, and other activities, featuring success stories;
- c. Showcasing the potential capabilities of children and youth with intellectual disabilities;
- d. Conducting dialogues with parents, service providers, and stakeholders on the theme of the Celebration;
- e. Discussing effective practices and systems of approach to better improve inclusion of children and youth with intellectual disabilities in the classroom, school, and community during meetings in regular classes or school programs; and,
- f. Organizing day camp to provide opportunities for children and youth with disabilities to explore and learn while having fun and to highlight the Celebration of National Intellectual Disability Week.

The National Capital Region (NCR), and the Quezon City Government (QCG), in coordination with DepEd-NCR, Philippine Association for Intellectual Disabilities Inc., Junior Chamber International Quezon City Capitol, and Manila Water (MW) and the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage System (MWSS), will sponsor the Annual Camp Pag-ibig at the Balara Filter Plant, Quezon City on **February 16, 2025**. Children enrolled in SNED classes, including teachers, administrators, and supervisors are encouraged to join the activity. Conduct of similar activities in all regions is encouraged.

All other details stipulated in the said Memorandum remain the same.
