






SUGGESTED PROGRAM FLOW FOR MOVING UP/COMPLETION/GRADUATION EXERCISES AND RECOGNITION DAY

To

Schools Division Superintendents

Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads

All Others Concerned

- 1. In accordance with DepEd Order (DO) No. 9, series of 2023, it is stated that: Moving up or graduation ceremonies should be held in a dignified and fitting manner for the graduating students and their families. These events must not serve as a platform for political discussions, in strict adherence to DO No. 48, s. 2018, titled Prohibition of Electioneering and Partisan Political Activity.
- 2. In this regard, this Office reminds all concerned personnel to continue adhering to the guidelines outlined in DO No. 48, s. 2018 and Section IV.5 (e) of DO No. 9, series of 2023.
- 3. The school heads should ensure that End-of-School-Year (EOSY) rites are celebrated through a solemn, simple, meaningful ceremony. While these mark a milestone in the lives of the learners, graduation/completion/moving up ceremonies shall be conducted without excessive spending, extravagant attire, or extraordinary venues. It should be principally aimed at recognizing the hard work, growth, and academic achievements of our graduates/completers while also commemorating the collective efforts of the entire school community in fulfilling the mandate of providing quality basic education to Filipino learners.
- 4. In order to establish uniformity, while adhering to the above-mentioned DepEd Orders on the conduct of the EOSY rites, this Office releases the Sample Program Flow for Moving Up/Completion/Graduation and Recognition Day for all elementary and secondary schools in Region III.






