

Greetings!

We hope this letter finds you in excellent health and spirits. We are Alfred Valencia and Charliene Dador, Directors of Kinaadman: Tagisan sa Panitikan 2025 under Katha Philippines.

Katha Philippines is a social justice organization dedicated to nurturing a love for the arts, culture, and literature through community projects, volunteer drives, and scholastic activities. Since its establishment in 2020, the organization has launched various initiatives, including flagship events such as PasKulit: Pasko para sa mga Bulilit (Years 1 to 3), SakloLoad: Free Load Assistance in Times of Calamities, and the Abucay Health Caravan. In line with our commitment to cultural enrichment and promoting Philippine literature, we are thrilled to present the Second Edition of Kinaadman: Tagisan sa Panitikan.

Kinaadman: Tagisan sa Panitikan 2025 derives its name from the Cebuano word *kinaadman*, meaning wisdom or knowledge. The event comprises three parts: a **lecture**, a **roundtable discussion**, and a **competition**. All aim to foster the development of different skills, enhance understanding, and cultivate a deeper appreciation and passion for **Philippine literature**.

Building on the success of the pilot year, *Kinaadman* began as a course project under the Applied Psychology Department of the University of the Philippines Diliman—Clark Extension. The inaugural event was held on April 27, 2024, at Bataan Christian College Inc. (BCCI) in Pilar, Bataan, with over 120 participants from eight schools across the Divisions of Bataan and Balanga. Inspired by this achievement, Katha Philippines aims to expand its reach within the province and continue promoting the art of literature, nurturing a new generation of young Francisco Balagtases in Bataan, where the renowned poet spent a significant part of his life.

In 2025, Katha Philippines will hold the project's second edition at Bataan National High School - Senior High School (BNHS-SHS) on April 12, 2025. Kinaadman will feature a range of literary contests across multiple categories in both Filipino and English, including (1) Essay Writing, (2) Pagsulat ng Sanaysay, (3) Poem Writing, (4) Pagsulat ng Tula, (5) News



Writing, (6) Pagsulat ng Balita, (7) Photo Essay, (8) Sanaysay ng Larawan, (9) Spoken Word Poetry, and (10) Pautakan sa Bataan | General Knowledge Quiz Bee. This event aligns with the **National Literature Month (Pambansang Buwan ng Panitikan)**, **celebrated every April** as proclaimed in **Proclamation No. 968 of 2015**, led by the National Commission on Culture and the Arts (NCCA), National Book Development Board (NBDB), and Komisyon sa Wikang Filipino (KWF).

The event is open to all high school students (Grades 7-12) enrolled in secondary schools during the current school year in the Division of Balanga City and the Division of Bataan. Katha Philippines, as a non-profit organization, has maintained FREE REGISTRATION to provide more schools with the opportunity to participate in the event. The organization will impose a maximum limit of 15 schools per division—15 from the Division of Balanga City and 15 from the Division of Bataan—totaling 30 schools (subject to future changes). Schools must register for at least six categories to participate in the event. The registration can be accessed through Katha Philippines' Facebook page at facebook.com/KathaPHL or directly through this link at bit.ly/KDM25Register.

This event offers students a memorable and enriching experience that underscores the value of literature in the contemporary context. In line with this, we seek your <u>APPROVAL</u> specifically requesting the <u>dissemination</u> of the event through a <u>memorandum</u> or advisory to all schools in Bataan. Please refer to the attached timeline and contest guidelines. <u>We hope for your favorable response on or before March 10, 2025.</u>

II. Participants

- Registration is ENTIRELY FREE and open to secondary level students (grades 7 to 12) from Balanga City & Bataan Schools.
- The participating schools pool will be limited to the first thirty (30) registrants.
 - Fifteen (15) schools from the Division of Balanga City
 - o Fifteen (15) schools from the Division of Bataan
 - Each participating school must have at least six (6) delegates.
- Each participating school can send only a maximum of one (1) student per category.
- Every participant must attend the learning session of their respective categories of interest. Failure to comply will lead to disqualification.
- The Top Ten will be awarded according to the decision of the speaker-judge assigned to
 each contest category. The decisions of the speaker-judges are final and irrevocable
 unless discrepancies with the announced results are proven.
- The top seven (7) ranking schools will also be awarded based on the average placements of their winning participants across all categories from their school.
- Participants will be registered per school through Google Forms:

- A finalized list of participants will be sent to each participating school's coaches via email or Messenger. Corrections and confirmations via reply email will be accepted 48 hours after the notice in which no further adjustments can be made.
- A finalized list of participating schools will be posted on Katha PH's social media pages.



III. Contest Rules & Guidelines

A. All Categories

All competition categories are composed of three parts:

- Every participant must attend the learning session of their respective categories of
 interest. Failure to comply will lead to disqualification. Students must wear their
 respective school's PE uniform, official daily uniform, or student publication uniform,
 along with their identification card (ID) for better classification.
- Each participating school can send only a maximum of one (1) student per category.
- The allotted time for contest categories, during which participants must complete their outputs, which are then submitted at the end of the writing session, is as follows:

Essay Writing	1 hour	News Writing	1 hour
Pagsulat ng Sanaysay	1 hour	Pagsulat ng Balita	1 hour
Poem Writing	1 hour	Photo Essay	2 hours
Pagsulat ng Tula	1 hour	Sanaysay ng Larawan	2 hours
Spoken Word Poetry	3 hours	Pautakan Sa Bataan: Gen Knowledge Quiz Bee	1 hour and 30 minutes

B. Photography Categories*

- All types of 15 to 25 megapixels digital cameras are allowed except film cameras, phones, and tablets. The camera's WiFi and Bluetooth must be strictly turned off throughout the entire event, if applicable.
- SD cards will be inspected on event day, and card slots will be sealed with stickers.
 Tampering with seals will lead to investigation and possible disqualification if intentional.

C. Spoken Word Poetry (Filipino)

- The theme/topic for the spoken word poetry contest will be posted two (2) days before
 the contest proper through Katha Philippines' social media pages.
- Prepared pieces must not exceed five (5) minutes per participant.
- A one (1) point deduction will be incurred for every thirty (30) seconds of overtime.

D. Battle of the Brains

- The quiz will consist of 40 questions, with each correct answer earning one (1) point.
- Schools must bring their own markers/chalk and illustration boards/whiteboards.
- The areas of knowledge covered will include:
