**CONTINUED CONDUCT OF TESDA FREE NATIONAL CERTIFICATION
ASSESSMENT FOR SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 003, s. 2025, the Schools Division Office of Bataan issues this Memorandum to serve as a quick reference guide for all school heads, TVL coordinators, and concerned personnel on the Continuation of the Conduct of TESDA Free National Certification Assessment for Senior High School Students of DepEd Bataan.
2. The TESDA Free National Certification (NC) Assessment is open to eligible Grade 11, Grade 12, and TVL track graduates of School Years 2022-2023, 2023-2024, and 2024-2025, with priority given to recently graduated Grade 12 learners.
3. Assessment fees will be fully covered by TESDA funds per TESDA Circular No. 45, s. 2024. However, any incidental expenses such as transportation, meals, and supplies shall be charged against available school or division funds, subject to established accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. Student-Assesseees must prepare the following:
 - a. valid School ID or Certification
 - b. notebook and black ballpen for note-taking
 - c. personal hygiene kit (alcohol, face mask, sanitizer)
 - d. be at the assessment venue no later than 7:30 AM on their scheduled date
5. School Heads and TVL Coordinators are directed to:
 - a. ensure students are well-informed and oriented about the assessment requirements and procedures;



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- b. facilitate the submission of duly accomplished Application Forms and Self-Assessment Guides (SAGs);
 - c. coordinate closely with the Division SHS Secretariat for technical and administrative concerns;
 - d. monitor attendance and readiness of students before, during, and after the conduct of assessments.
6. All TESDA-certified competency assessors shall conduct the assessments following TESDA regulations. Strict compliance to safety protocols and TESDA competency standards is expected at all times.
7. This Memorandum shall also serve as the official Travel Authority for all identified student-assesseees, their assigned teacher-chaperones, and the Division SHS Secretariat listed in the attached schedule.
8. As stipulated under CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 4, s. 2004, teachers and personnel who will render services on weekends, holidays, or scheduled rest days due to TESDA assessments may avail of Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) or Service Credits, subject to existing DepEd guidelines.
9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is requested.
