
1. To strengthen the implementation of the Special Science Elementary School (SSES) Program and ensure the standardization of curriculum, instructional materials, and assessment strategies, the Schools Division Office of Bataan will conduct the Division Training on the Standardization and Unified Implementation of the SSES Program on May 22-23, 2025 at Mansion Garden Hotel, Subic, Zambales.

2. The training aims to:

- a) develop a unified framework for curriculum delivery, instructional strategies, and assessment methods in SSES schools;
- b) create standardized learning materials such as activity sheets, workbooks, and resource references to enhance teaching and learning;
- c) establish common assessment tools and evaluation metrics to ensure consistency in measuring student learning outcomes;
- d) provide capacity-building sessions for SSES school heads, coordinators, and teachers to effectively use standardized learning materials, and
- e) foster collaboration and knowledge-sharing among SSES educators for continuous improvement in science education.

3. The participants to the training are the Education Program Supervisor in Science, Technical Working Group, SSES School Heads, SSES Teachers from San Ramon Elementary School, Limay Elementary School, Orani North Elementary School, and Cabcaben Elementary School.

4. Meals and venue expenses is charged against the Division INSET Fund, while travel expenses may be charged to the School Maintenance and Other



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Operating Expenses (MOOE) or other available local funds, subject to existing accounting and auditing regulations.

6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired


