1. In line with DepEd Memorandum No. 042, s. 2025, titled 2025 Brigada Eskwela Implementing Guidelines, the Department of Education Region III will hold its **Regional Brigada Eskwela Kick-Off** on **June 9, 2025**, from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., hosted by the Schools Division of Tarlac Province at Tarlac National High School.

2. *Brigada Eskwela* is a yearly initiative that embodies the Filipino spirit of bayanihan, bringing together stakeholders—parents, teachers, students, alumni, LGUs, NGOs, and other community partners—to prepare schools for the opening of classes through clean-up drives, repairs, repainting, and facility maintenance.
