# DRUG-FREE FUTURE: BARKADA KONTRA BISYO AND KABATAAN IWAS DROGA AT SIGARILYO KICK-OFF CELEBRATION YEAR 2

- In line with the Department of Education's commitment to promoting a drugfree environment and empowering students to lead healthy and productive lives, this Office, through the Learner Formation Section, announces the official launch of the United for a Drug-Free Future: BKB and KIDS Kick-Off Celebration Year 2 in all schools under its jurisdiction on June 11, 2025.
- The BKB and KIDS program is an initiative aimed at raising awareness about the dangers of drug abuse, fostering peer support, and encouraging students to participate in activities that promote a drug-free lifestyle. This initiative is in support of the national agenda to combat illegal drugs and to nurture responsible and healthy citizens.
- The activity is open to all Barkada Kontra Bisyo and Kabataan Iwas Droga at Sigarilyo Organizations.
- 4. The objectives are the following:
  - · Educate students about the harmful effects of drug abuse;
  - Engage students in meaningful activities that promote a drug-free lifestyle;
  - Encourage peer support and community involvement in drug prevention efforts; and

- Strengthen collaboration between schools, communities, and local government units (LGUs) in the fight against drugs.
- 5. Suggested activities for the BKB and KIDS Kick-Off Ceremony:
  - Parade and Opening Program: A parade within the school premises, followed by an opening program featuring guest speakers from local government units (LGUs), non-governmental organizations (NGOs), and other stakeholders.
  - Awareness Talks and Workshops: Sessions on the dangers of drug abuse, signs and symptoms of drug addiction, and strategies for prevention and intervention.
  - Pledge of Commitment: Students, teachers, and staff will take a pledge to stay drug-free and support the BKD program.
  - Creative Presentations: Performances, poster-making contests, and other creative activities to reinforce the anti-drug message.
  - Wellness or fitness programs such as Zumba, Bicycle campaigns, Color/Fun Runs, or any Sports Activities to enhance students' physical health and well-being. These activities should be designed to engage students in fun and healthy practices that promote a drug-free and smoke-free lifestyle.

#### 6. Implementation:

- Schools are encouraged to coordinate with their local government units,
   NGOs, and other stakeholders to support the event.
- The School Heads and BKB/KIDS Advisers and Officers shall be in charge of organizing and overseeing the Kick-Off Ceremony.
- All activities should adhere to the Department of Education's guidelines on safety and health protocols, ensuring the well-being of all participants.
- The activities should be conducted in accordance with the No Collection Policy, or Republic Act No. 5546, titled 'An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and/or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges, and Universities.'
- The Division Learner Formation Section and the Division Association of Barkada Kontra Droga Advisers shall monitor the conduct of the BKB and
