These heattrapping pollutants- specifically carbon dioxide, methane, nitrous oxide, water vapour, and synthetic fluorinated gases- are known as greenhouse gases, and their impact is called "the greenhouse effect".

Based on the reports, we are suffering from the greenhouse effect. The average temperature of earth's surface continuously increasing due to greenhouse gases that collect in the atmosphere like a thickening blanket, trapping the sun's heat and causing
