### SELECTION OF MARKET-SCOPED SUPPLEMENTARY LEARNING **RESOURCES FOR SCHOOL LIBRARIES**

Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 227, s. 2025; DepEd Order No. 24, s. 2023 (as amended by DO No. 14, s. 2024); and DM-CT-2025-047, and in line with the 2025 National and Regional Market Scoping activities, the Schools Division Office of Bataan, through the Curriculum Implementation Division – Learning Resources Management and Development Section (CID-LRMDS), will conduct the Selection of Market-Scoped Supplementary Learning Resources (SLRs) for School Libraries on August 14, 2025, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at AMPC, Magtanong St., Calaylayan, Abucay, Bataan.

This activity aims to assist School SLR Committees in selecting appropriate titles for their libraries from the consolidated list of SLRs identified, evaluated, and procured by the Regional Offices—ensuring diverse, updated, and non-duplicative collections.

Specifically, the activity aims to:

- a. familiarize the School Library SLR Committee members with the updated list of identified, evaluated, and procured SLRs from the Regional Offices:
- **b.** select suitable titles for each school library based on identified needs, grade levels served, and existing collection gaps;
- c. ensure the avoidance of duplicate titles in library collections to maximize diversity and relevance; and
- d. finalize and consolidate the selected titles for procurement through downloaded funds from the DepEd Central Office – Bureau of Learning Resources.

Priority SLRs to be selected and procured shall reflect the following themes in support of the revised curriculum and the current priorities of the Department:

- **a.** For School Libraries (Elementary)
  - Globes and maps
  - General references for Early Childhood Care and Development
  - Learning area references for Kindergarten to Grade 3 learning areas
- **b.** For School Libraries (JHS/SHS)
  - Globes and maps
  - General references for Mathematics, Science and Technology, and Technology and Vocational Education (TVE)
  - Learning area references for Mathematics, Science, Information and Communication Technology, and core and applied subjects

Participants shall consist of the members of the **Division Technical Working** Group (TWG) and the School Head from each of the sixty-one (61) beneficiary schools, all of whom must be proficient in spreadsheet applications.

If the School Head is unable to attend, an authorized representative who must be a member of the School SLR Committee and possess the same required proficiency in Excel may be designated to decide on the SLRs to be procured, provided that a duly accomplished replacement letter is submitted on or before the scheduled date of the activity. Only those who meet this qualification shall be allowed to participate.

Each school is requested to bring a laptop and extension cord for use during the selection sessions.

Meals and snacks of the participants shall be charged to the Division Office MOOE, while their travel expenses for attending the activity may be charged against the respective school's MOOE or local fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

For reference, the list of recipient schools and the detailed matrix of activities are attached to this Memorandum.

This Division Letter also serves as the Travel Authority for the participants.

Immediate and wide dissemination of this Letter is desired.
