#### OBSERVANCE OF ENGLISH COMPETENCY WEEK

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

- 1. Pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 19, Series of 2022, otherwise known as "An Ordinance Declaring the First Week of September of Every Year as English Competency Week in the Province of Bataan", the Schools Division Office of Bataan shall observe the annual English Competency Week to further strengthen the skills of both learners and teachers across various disciplines. This weeklong celebration aims to align educational initiatives with the province's thrust toward promoting academic excellence, technical proficiency, and holistic development.
- 2. The English Competency Week aims to:
  - a. Raise awareness of the importance of attaining and improving English proficiency.
  - b. Increase interest in the use of English
  - c. Promote the further use of English
- 3. The English Competency Week will be observed starting September 1, 2025. During this period, schools are encouraged to conduct activities that may include, but are not limited to, the following: debates, declamations, essay writing contests, editorial writing, news writing contests, feature writing contests, public speaking workshops, discussion forums, spelling bees, quiz bees, poetry writing contests, poetry readings, extemporaneous speaking, and choral reading.
- 4. All schools are required to:
  - a. Prepare and submit a detailed plan of activities for the English Competency Week to the Division Office, through their respective Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS), by September 1, 2025.
  - b. Ensure that activities are inclusive and promote participation from all students, including those with special needs.



















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- c. Document and report the outcomes of the English Competency Week activities for each school, compile the reports by district, and submit them to the Division Office by September 13, 2025.
- 5. The Division Office, through the Education Program Supervisors, shall monitor the implementation of English Competency Week activities. A post-event evaluation will be conducted to assess the effectiveness of the activities and identify areas for improvement.
- 6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

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
