COUNCIL MEMORANDUM No. 07 S. 2025

TO: **DISTRICT SCOUT COMMISSIONERS, INSTITUTIONAL HEADS
SCOUT LEADERS, SCOUTS**

1. We are pleased to announce the holding of 31st Bataan Council Scout Jamboree on October 25 - 29, 2025 Hosted by the City of Balanga Bataan at Barangay Dangcol with the theme, "Ready for Life: Scouts for Peace and Sustainable Development".
2. The educational objectives of this activity are:
 - It seeks to offer opportunities for young people to grow in all dimensions --- physically, intellectually, socially and spiritually and to help them in the area of peace and human understanding.
 - It aims to offer young people new ideas so that they are capable of taking active part in improving life in their local, national, international communities.
3. Considering the significance of the knowledge and values that can be imbedded in attending this event, it is expected that each district and secondary schools will organize, orient and send more Patrols/Crews/Troops/Outfits of physically fit Scouts.
4. A Camp Fee of SEVEN HUNDRED PESOS (Php 700.00) shall be levied each scout and scouter to cover souvenir items and administrative expenses chargeable against local funds (MOOE/SEF/CANTEEN) and other scouting funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. In order to provide the Council Office the much needed logistical and administrative preparation, a reservation fee of THREE HUNDRED PESOS (Php 300.00) none refundable but transferable shall be made not later than October 03, 2025. This also will determine the strength of participation and to give ample time for the preparation of program materials, souvenir items and other administrative concern.
6. Troop/Outfit Roster, Registration Form are hereto attached as Enclosures Nos. 1, and 2, respectively.
7. Your usual support and cooperation is earnestly desired to ensure a successful and memorable scout camp for our young boys.
