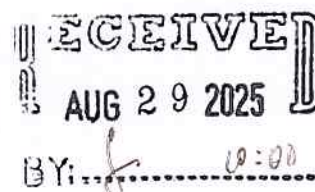

CONTEST MECHANICS

1. MARIAN QUIZ BEE

2. Participants for the Marian Quiz Bee shall compose of 1 team for every category. The first team includes (1) Grade 3 and (1) Grade 4 while the second team is composed of (1) Grade 5 and (1) Grade 6.
3. The contest shall revolve from Easy, Average, and Difficult rounds. In case of tie, clincher round will be observed.
4. Easy round is composed of 10 questions with 1 point for each correct answer. Participants will be given 20 seconds to answer the question.
5. Average round is composed of 10 questions with 2 points for each correct answer. Participants will be given 30 seconds to answer the question.
6. Difficult round is composed of 10 questions with 3 points for each correct answer. Participants will be given 60 seconds to answer the question.
7. Clincher round is composed of 5 questions with 5 points for each correct answer. Participants will be given 60 seconds to answer the question.
8. Each question will be repeated once. Participants will be asked to wait for the signal of the quiz master and when the bell rings, all participants are expected to show their answer.
9. Each team shall be accompanied by 1 teacher-coach only.

2. Marian Poster Making Contest

Mechanics for Poster Making Contest

1. The contest is open to all JHS or SHS student from each public/private school. One entry per school only.
2. The theme shall be announced during the contest proper.
3. Materials
 - a. Participants should bring their own art materials except for the ¼ illustration board to be provided by the organizer.
 - b. Any medium (oil pastel, crayons, and markers) may be used, except digital or printed images.
4. Participants will be given 2 hours to finish their posters.
5. Entries must be original and done on the spot. Plagiarized or copied works will be disqualified.
6. Judging Criteria
 - a. Relevance to the Theme – 40%
 - b. Creativity and Originality – 30%
 - c. Visual Impact and Presentation – 20%
 - d. Neatness – 10%
7. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.
8. All submitted posters will become the property of the organizers.



3. MEDIA CON Photo Contest

Theme: Virgen Milagrosa: Daluyan ng Grasya

Qualifications:

1. Bonafide Students of Public or Private School in Orani
2. 14 years old and above
3. Followers of the Official Page of @MinorBasilicaOfOrani
4. Own a DSLR Camera for photo shooting.

Scope/Coverage/ Topics:

1. natural water and land resources
2. Products of Orani
3. Culture and Arts of Orani
4. Livelihood within Orani
5. Devotion to the Blessed Mother

Mechanics:

1. Only 1 entry per group with members of max of 2 shall be considered contest piece.
2. The subject for each entry shall revolve only within Orani.
3. The entry may be in a portrait or landscape with 5mb photo file.
4. Entry shall be in original form and not used in any contest.

Criteria:

Relevance to the theme- 25%

Creativity and Originality-25%

Visual Impact-25%

Presentation-25%
