

Girl Scouts of the Philippines Postpones "Run as One" and "Long Green Line" Events Originally Scheduled on September 21, 2025, Manila, Philippines

The Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) announces the postponement of its two major events, the Run as One: A Celebration of Girl Scouts of the Philippines 85 Years in the Running and the Long Green Line, originally scheduled on September 21, 2025, at the Quirino Grandstand, Luneta, Manila.

This decision seriously considered the "Billion People Rally" on the same date and venue. In consultation with government agencies and local authorities, GSP prioritized the safety and security of all participants—particularly the thousands of Girl Scouts, most of whom are minors.

To date, more than 4,000 participants from various cities and municipalities in NCR and across Luzon have registered for the two activities. After close coordination with the National Parks Development Committee (NPDC), Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA), City of Manila, Manila Police District (MPD), Manila Traffic District Engineering Unit (MTDEU), Manila Traffic and Parking Bureau (MTPB), Manila Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO), Department Public Services (DPS), Manila Barangay Bureau (MBB), and Department of Tourism, Culture and Arts of Manila (DTCAM), the GSP has secured Saturday, September 27, 2025 as the new date for the Long Green Line event.

Meanwhile, the final date for Run As One will be announced in the coming week. We appeal for everyone's kind consideration.

The Girl Scouts of the Philippines extends its gratitude to its partner agencies for their support and understanding, and assures all participants that both events will continue as planned.
