PROVINCIAL CONSUMER QUIZ BEE October 10,2025 @ 1:00 P.M

Mechanics/Guidelines:

- 1. The Consumer Quiz Bee shall be held at the The Waltermart, Balanga City, Bataan;
- 2. Participants shall be required to wear their school uniform with ID;
- 3. Participants are required to be at the venue 15 minutes before the contest begins on October 10, 2025. The quiz bee proper will start at 1:00 pm.
- 4. Participants are not allowed to bring references. All cellular phones are required to be put in a silent mode
- 5. There will be four (4) rounds in the competition, namely: Easy, Average, Difficult and Final Round.
- 6. There will be 10 questions for the Easy Round. Contestant/s will get 5 pts for each correct answer
- 7. For the Average Round, 8 questions will be asked and contestant/s will get 10 pts for each correct answer.
- 8. For the Difficult Round, 5 questions will be asked and contestant/s will get 15 pts for each correct answer.
- 9. Only the top three (3) participants will proceed to the Final Round.
- 10. For the Final Round, scores will be back to zero and remaining participants will be given 5 questions with corresponding 20 pts for each correct answer.
- 11. Each guestion will follow this sequence:
 - The quizmaster will read the question twice and will be flashed on screen. A timer
 will start after the quizmaster says "Go" The participants are given the following
 time allocation for each question per round:

Easy round – 15 seconds Average round – 20 seconds Difficult round – 25 seconds Final round – 30 seconds

- The participants should write the full answer on the provided writing material in correct spelling and should conceal his/her answer on the cue of the quizmaster.
- A buzzer will be rung at the end of the timer, and the quizmaster will say "Time is up". All participants should stop writing at that point.
 On the signal of the quizmaster, all answers shall be revealed;
- The correct answer will then be posted on-screen and announced by the quizmaster.
- Only complete and correct answers will be given points. Acronyms and abbreviations will NOT be considered as correct answers.
- Assigned CPD PO associate will record the scores of each participant.
- After the answers and scores are recorded, the participants will be allowed to lower the answer sheet in preparation for the next question.
- In case of a tie, a tie breaker will immediately ensue. The participant who will first answer the tie breaker question correctly will be declared as the victor.
- Questions will be drawn from the following topics: Consumer Rights and Responsibilities. RA 7394, RA 11148, Price Act, Sustainable Development Goals and different Fair-Trade Laws.

- 12. If protests/clarifications are raised, the contestants are advised not to erase their answers until the protests are settled. The decision of the Protest Committee composed of DTI-Bataan Provincial Office Consumer Protection Division representatives is final and irrevocable.
- 13. The participants with the highest score will be declared the Champion. The next two highest scoring participants will be declared First and Second runner up.
- 14. The committee will act on any concern regarding the questions and answers only. The winners of the quiz bee will receive a Certificate of Recognition with the following prizes in the form of **Gift Certificates**:

Champion 3,000.00
 First Runner-up 2,000.00
 Second Runner-up 1,000.00

15. Non-winning contestants will receive a Certificate of Participation.

PROVINCIAL SPOKEN POETRY CONTEST October 17, 2025,1:00 pm at Waltermart, Balanga City,Bataan

The Provincial Spoken Poetry Contest encourages young poets to express their creativity and insights through original spoken word pieces focused on consumerism. By showcasing their talents, participants will raise awareness about consumer issues while honing their public speaking and performance skills. Each province will be represented by one student participant.

Mechanics/Guidelines:

- 1. Participants shall actually recite her/his piece which will be in English or Filipino.
- 2. The piece must be related to Consumerism and should be an original work of the participant.
- 3. Participants attire: School Uniform and must wear his/her School I.D.
- 4. An instrumental or musical background shall be optional;
- 5. Order of recitation will be done alphabetically based on the municipality being represented;
- 6. All contestants will be judged with the following criteria:

•	Relevance to the consumerism	25%
•	Stage presence and presentation	25%
•	Coherence of form and structure	25%
•	Clarity or spoken words and diction	25%

•	Third Prize	P 1,000.00
