CLARIFICATION ON THE ROLES OF TEACHING AND NON-TEACHING PERSONNEL DURING THE SIMULTANEOUS INFRASTRUCTURE ASSESSMENT, STRUCTURAL INTEGRITY EVALUATION AND AUDIT OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS (Division Memorandum No. 461, s. 2025)

All Others Concerned

- 1. This is to clarify the implementation of Division Memorandum No. 461, s. 2025, regarding the province-wide Simultaneous Infrastructure Assessment, Structural Integrity Evaluation, and Audit of School Buildings scheduled on October 16-17, 2025.
- **2.** In line with this activity:
- **2.1** Teaching Personnel and Learners All public schools from Kindergarten to Senior High School shall suspend face-to-face classes during the said dates. Teaching personnel are directed to implement the Alternative Delivery Modalities (ADM) as previously prescribed to ensure the continuity of learning; and
- **2.2 Non-Teaching Personnel** (including Job Order, Contract of Service, and PSB staff) All non-teaching personnel are **instructed to report to their respective schools** to **render assistance** during the conduct of inspection, audit, inventory, and documentation of assessment results. This includes **utility workers**, **security guards**, **and other support staff** as may be designated by the School Head.
- 3. The Role of Non-Teaching Personnel are as follows:
 - 3.1 Assist the School Heads, School Infrastructure Units (SIUs), and District Supervisors during the inspection and audit;

- 3.2 Ensure smooth coordination and documentation of the assessment, including inventorying of school facilities; and
- 3.3 Provide support for emergency preparedness and safety protocols as necessary.
- **4. Members of the School DRRM Teams** are directed to render technical assistance and provide emergency response support throughout the duration of the assessment to ensure preparedness and safety within school premises.
- **5.** This **Memorandum** is issued to ensure the efficient and orderly implementation of the inspection and assessment activities while upholding **safety, security, and coordination** in all public schools.
- **6.** For immediate dissemination and strict compliance.
