If you have your DepEd email that ends with @deped.gov.ph, you can access the premium version without paying anything. You just need to sign up or log-in using your DepEd email account.

Second, Smart Cast is a useful accessory to project lessons. If your classroom has existing LED TV, you just have to connect the Smart Cast tool to the HDMI port while the other end is connected to a laptop. It can even work with a smart phone and ipad or any compatible tablet device.
